We work with talented players (7-21 years of age) who have the ability and desire to play basketball in a competitive environment. We seek to build high character student-athletes who bring a commitment and joy to the game, as well as being distinguished for the integrity and class they bring to the sport, their families and their community. Team Hurricane Basketball Academy provides a platform in which student-athletes can train, develop and reach their academic and athletic potential. We seek to provide the best competitive basketball experience for student-athletes who want to pursue a college education. Our programs include training, mentoring, academic tutoring and assisting student-athletes in navigating the college recruiting process.

GLOBAL EDUCATIONAL & TRAINING PROGRAM

Team Hurricane Basketball Academy new Global Educational & Training & Program is to attract talented international student-athletes to take part in intensive academic & basketball training here in Bermuda. We seek to attract those students primarily from Africa, While training at the Team Hurricane Basketball Academy, these student-athletes will have the opportunity to do academic and enrichment coursework through our Hurricane Preparatory Academy, Bermuda College and/or other educational programming centers in Bermuda or online.

The mission of this program is to provide a rigorous instructional program whereby students will have unique opportunities to infuse their academic learning with basketball training. International student-athletes will have an opportunity to take part in a program that is dedicated to the advancement of its student-athletes to the collegiate level through academic preparation, exposure, exclusive player development, and elite competition.

Collegiate coaches are highly selective in their student-athlete search. As a result, players who come through a strong post-graduate program have a recruiting edge by becoming a well-rounded prospect athletically, academically, and socially. An additional year of athletic performance training, academic profile improvement, and physical maturation, gives Team Hurricane student-athletes the ability to transition more effectively at the collegiate level on the court, in the classroom, and socially.

Team Hurricane will work tirelessly to market, promote, and expose the potential of its players with a national level schedule in front of 100+ college coaches on the NCAA Division I, II, III, NAIA, Junior College, and Community College.

Through intensive on-court skills training, basketball specific athletic performance training, and top-level competition, our student-athletes gain the skills and experience necessary to expand their college recruitment and create additional options for their collegiate careers.

It will also be Team Hurricane's intent to bring high earning salaried Division 1 College Coaches to evaluate our student-athletes at an NCAA Certified event here in Bermuda.

Scholarship-Tuition Assistance

Team Hurricane Basketball Academy seeks donor support that will enable the program to provide scholarship-tuition assistance that will allow 8 - 10 student-athletes from around the globe to participate in this Global Educational & Training Program. Such support will go towards tuition, student housing, books and meals.

Team Hurricane provides academic assessment and tutoring as well as additional coursework that may not be offered by Bermuda College which may include SAT/ACT preparation as well as skills and communication prep work training.



- Transcripts with a 2.0 Core GPA
- Attendance in school is mandatory (understanding that basketball and school work relates directly toward qualifying for college)
- ❖ A full sports physical
- Letters of recommendation (coaches or teachers)
- ❖ A one page essay from applicant stating why they would like to be apart of Hurricane Preparatory and our Post Graduate program
- Able to get along with your peers in school, housing, and on the court
- ❖ Willing to become a TEAM player and understanding the importance of TEAM especially on the court
