- We provide free reconstructive surgery operations for the poor population in Tajikistan
- Our average costs per operation are \$210-270, including tools, hospitalization fees, medications, pre-surgery tests and transportation for medical staff
- All donations go strictly to the surgeries. Fund administration overheads are covered by the fund trustees.

KEY GOALS & ACHIEVEMENTS

WE AIM:

• To change the lives of at least 1000 individuals by 31 December 2020

WE HAVE :

- A team of highly experiences plastics & reconstructive surgeons and nurses
- Support of the modern and well-quipped Danghara Medical Hospital, which provides its facilities for the surgery and postsurgery treatment
- A dedicated administration team, whose overheads are covered by the fund trustees

WE ACHIEVED:

• 423 free constructive surgeries delivered since the start of the project in the early 2016



For 343 operations, at least :

- \$23 pre-surgery tests (200 TJS)
- \$45 anesthesia (400 TJS)
- \$45 consumables & surgical instruments (400 TJS)
- \$97 transportation, living & other expenses for medical staff (860 TJS)
- \$210 (1860 TJS) total per operation

Patients usually paid :

- \$68 for hospitalization fees (600 TJS)
- Post-surgery medications

10 surgeries fully funded by Body Surgery

TYPES OF SURGERIES

- traumatic injuries of the limbs
- traumatic head and neck injuries
- operations in the event of damage to the limbs SNP
- chronic injuries of the nerves of the extremities
- defects of integumentary tissues
- post-traumatic and post-burn cicatricial contractures
- congenital anomalies of the face
- acquired facial aesthetic defects
- operations on the mammary gland
- operations on the front abdominal wall
- operations on the organs of the genitourinary system
- bronchial asthma resection of the internal branch of the superior laryngeal nerve
