

-ATRAHDOM-EXECUTIVE SUMMARY PROMOTION AND DEFENSE OF THE HUMAN LABOR RIGHTS OF WOMEN WORKERS.

ATRAHDOM, we organized at the end of 2007, for November 25, 2009, we reached our legal framework, in almost two years of management, we promoted activities without legal framework in order to strengthen us and consider whether legalization was possible. Given our favorable results to our concerns, we obtained the solidarity of a lawyer for our legalization.

The Organizational Structure:

- 1. Assembly
- 2. Board of Directors
- 3. Technical team

We are governed by our statutes, and we have internal regulations, a commission for the resolution of conflicts and we have a regulation of administrative and fiscal procedures. We carry out periodic audits and those audited by the auditors.

The Technical, Administrative and Political Executing Technical Unit is the Board of Directors. Even though we are not a union, we are the benchmark of many spaces such as the International Labor Organization, on the issue of working women.

The work axes are:

The promotion and defense of women's human and labor rights through education and training,
Political advocacy, coordination with other organizations and dialogue, with labor justice operators in the country,

3. We work in the field of research, to know specific cases of the situation of the workers, how to keep updated statistical data, and information about the labor branches.

4. Legal advice and accompaniment.

"Vision: Women workers of the Home, Home and Maquila know their human and labor rights and put them into practice to improve their living conditions.

" **Mission:** Provide support, accompaniment, training, training and advice to domestic workers, home and maquila. Achieve changes in the current national legislature, which will eradicate discrimination, economic, labor and human rights of working women

Our Objective: Integral and human development of women domestic workers, at home, maquila and rural, in the areas of training and education, research, advocacy on women, development, peace, eradication of labor violence and against women, occupational health.

Some of our great achievements:

1. We participate in legislative processes, to achieve reforms to the labor code in favor of women workers in the countryside and in the city. We have taken a deep effort since 2010 to reach an ILO Convention, reaching 189, in the 100th. CIT, in 2011, and we have taken 6 years of hard management, political, technical and social, to achieve the ratification of the agreement, which on October 27, 2016 I am in 2nd. Reading in the Congress of the Republic.

2. We participate in spaces such as the paritaria of the minimum wage in the activities of the export and the maquila.

3. We have developed 5 Congresses of women workers, with more than 100 participants, 30 organizations and 7 thematic tables, the results are part of our work policy platform. And we also sent a final declaration of each Congress to the International Labor Conference, in order to denounce the violation of the labor rights of the workers in Guatemala.

4. In 2012, we organized and achieved the legalization of the first union of domestic workers, SITRADOMSA, which now operates autonomously.

5. We have participated in activities for Peace and Nonviolence in Guatemala.

6. We have a department of procurement and legal accompaniment for female workers who need such advice and accompaniment.

7. We surpassed the 148 members as base women, as domestic workers, maquila, from the field, vendors by catalog.

8. We have a Resource Mobilization Plan.
