2012-2013

Procured 35 acres of land in Mali and incorporated in Boulder, CO, USA as a 501(c)3 organization



2015

Added 10,000 pounds of fresh crops to food supply.



2014

Expanded program 793% - grew from 30 to 238 people (186 women & 52 young adults)



2016

Launched microloan program, introduced 2 craft product lines, trained 50 interns, and delivered 11 speaking engagements

2017

Laid foundation for Drip Irrigation Systems to expand access of water to farms



2019

Expanded into Guinea, established partnerships with iDAMA 4U & Djimi Djama, and planted 1,200 moringa trees. New partnerships expand mobile learning capabilities as well as craft product line exposure to global markets.



2018

Expanded into Ivory Coast & Senegal, grew 200% to 386 members, and raised \$9,000 for farming modernization projects



2020

Drill Water Well, continued irrigation expansion... and more



In 7 years, we have made 405 partnerships and positively affected 500,000+ lives in West Africa

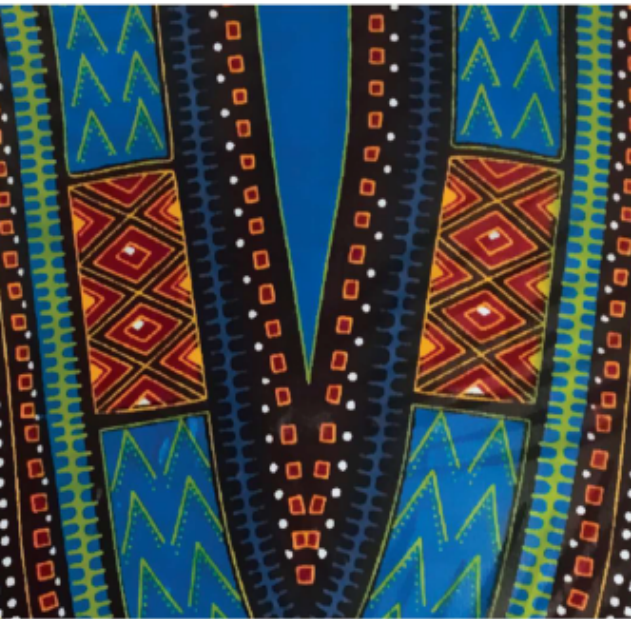
