Children 8-12

Royal Family Kids is an international camp and mentorship program designed for abused and neglected children, and has been running since 2003.

Camping

The uniqueness of this programs (5 consecutive days focused on individual attention, with the adult to child ration set at 1 to 2), allowing the self -worth of the children to be enriched and their resilience built up. It is also a time where happy memories are created for these children.

Mentorship

Is an extension of the camping program, allowing volunteers the opportunity to invest more in the lives of the children. The ration is a 1 adult to 1 child, where the mentors spend 4 hours a month for 10 months with their mentees' further strengthening the child's sense of self worth.



Men & Ladies of Honours

Teens 13-17

The Men and Ladies of Honour programs are gender based programs aimed at risk teens.

This program is made up of weekly one-hour mentorship meetings and two week-end camps using the character-specific Men of Honour [™] and Ladies of Honour [™] Curriculum, as well as the Ed Cole Majoring in Men[™] Curriculum.
