To improve the quality of health for poor people by ensuring access to essential medicines.

#### WHO WE ARE

The Medicine Open Access Initiative (MOA-I) is a project of the Institute of Asian American Adult Development (IAAAD) established as a 501(c)3 non-profit organization to address the issues of unaffordable and inaccessible essential drugs for the poor. MOA-I has developed a business model that provides free and low-cost drugs to the poor who need them most. MOA-I builds a network of low-cost distribution of essential drugs and a drug pipeline, where policy and regulatory barriers left millions of poor and neglected patients with inadequate or even no medical treatments. MOA-I also advocates making drugs affordable and accessible through reformation of intellectual property pharmaceutical laws.
