

TEJUS HOME



It is taboo to talk about sex in our culture – it is difficult to talk about sex abuse and talking about child sexual abuse is even more difficult.

Across cultures it has been shown that one in every five children is sexually abused, and that in 90% of the cases, the abuser is somebody known to the child.

India's ability to protect children from sexual abuse falls far short of meeting the existing needs. In addition, there is a widespread lack of awareness among parents, teachers, children, policy makers and the criminal justice system about the existence and complexities of this issue.

Child sexual abuse has both short-term and long-term consequences – for the child and the family. Preventing sexual violation of children and offering professional support to children who have been abused is a huge challenge.

Tejus Home is a partnership between two NGOs- Dil Se and Birth for Change. Working with children, Dil Se came across abused, pregnant teenagers. These girls not only faced stigma and rejection by the family and the community; they had no place they could go to which would care for them adequately and appropriately. Dil Se felt called into action – and Tejus Home opened in November 2012. This home, with its caring environment, provides the girls a safe and nurturing place to live in during one of the most difficult times of their lives. Thanks to Birth for Change, the home offers the possibility of a healthy pregnancy, a natural delivery and the time to repair their bodies and mind following an often traumatic situation of abuse. Counseling support enables the girls to deal with the abuse, and not just survive, but thrive. As far as we know, Tejus Home is the only home in India, which is specifically for pregnant teens.


Here are some of the services we offer:

- Information and resources to help the girls make choices about their pregnancy, their baby, and their future.
- Encouragement to continue education during pregnancy and after birth.
- Birth preparation and education classes
- Individualized health care: prenatal, birth and postnatal care with a midwife.
- Legal Support
- Sexuality education.
- Life-skills training: self-confidence and self-esteem, assertiveness, finances, home management, gardening etc.

Dil Se is legally and financially responsible for the home. We are a registered non-profit organisation (reg.no. 28/9) based in Kochi, Kerala. Our main focus is on prevention and healing of child sexual abuse. In March 2016, we opened a Child Advocacy Centre which focuses on this issue. The girls from Tejus Home, as well as their families, get the necessary support and counselling from our specialized staff: social, legal and psychological.

Birth for Change is responsible for running Tejus Home. They are also responsible for the pre-natal care, the delivery and post-natal care of the girls in the home. Birth for Change is a social responsibility venture (reg. no.104/111/2012) created by Birthvillage Natural Birthing Centre. It was formed to respond to the need for quality, respectful maternal health care for all women and girls, in all sectors of the population. It is dedicated to educate, advocate and support to ensure that our young community gets back to life with renewed commitment.
