#### 1.0 Background

Kiwonnongo Foundation Inc (KIFI) a community based organization supported by individuals from Lunya Municipality, Lwamata Parish; Lwamata Sub-county in Kiboga District. The CBO started way back in November 2016 and officially registered in Uganda with a registration number 232046 by the registrar of companies. It is also registered as a 501 c 3, FEI/EIN Number: 45-5455605, since 08/02/2012 with the state of Florida-USA.

#### 1.1 Location

Kiwonnongo Foundation Inc (KIFI) is located in Kiboga district Lwamata sub county Lwamata Parish in Lunya Municipality. It is 64 miles from Kampala city center along Hoima road at Lunya stage. It is located in the remote village of Lunya without Hydro electricity power, without clean piped water and with poor internet signals. Lunya population illiteracy rate is at 98%, being one of the highest in the nation.

From Kampala to Lunya village= 64 miles (Lunya Stage)
On Kampala-Hoima road north bound
It is about 6.7 km south of Lwamata Town on Kampala-Hoima Rd
It is about 14.28 km south of Kiboga Town Center

#### 2.0 TECHNICAL APPROACH

## 2.1 Program Description:

Kiwonnongo Children Education Projects, Youth and Women Capacity Building and Empowerment

#### 2.1.1 Problem Statement:

- A) Absence of safe and clean water, and lack of human excreta disposal with high rate of poor hygiene. In order to provide excellent, and efficient academic standards at minimal cost; to a population with 98% illiteracy rate, children need a safe hygienic and secure educational environment, especially a girl child. Without good sanitation, safe clean water, there shall be a low rate of enrollment and this will lead to increased rate of school dropout. As they drink and use contaminated water, preventable diseases are at its highest rate. The school and the surrounding environment lack clean safe water, with inadequate number of pit latrines (ventilated Pit Latrines).
- B) At St. Jerome Emilian Academy children still lack the dining hall facility, right now they eat from the open dusty environment exposing them to preventable diseases like diarrhea, cholera, dysentery, vomiting and other related infections that affect the class attendance that lead to poor performance and high drop outs.
- C) The problem of HIV and AIDS in Kiboga is increasing and on daily basis, People Living With HIV and AIDS (PLWHA) and those dying leaving behind Orphans and Vulnerable Children (OVC) are increasing. Inevitably, despite the previous efforts by the Kiwonnongo Foundation Inc, it still remains a challenge to adequately respond to this problem. The stakeholders of this community in our intervention area do not have proper information about; how HIV and AIDS is spread, how it can be protected and for those already infected with HIV virus, how they can be treated and access Voluntary Counseling and Treatment (VCT). Women in Uganda are the bread winners, but unfortunately most of them have been widowed by HIV and AIDS that have left most families especially in Kiboga district vulnerable. Service delivery agencies/information is not known to them.

#### 2.1.1.1 Description of the extent:

Kiwonnongo Foundation Inc (KIFI) is one of the Community Based Organization and is implementing their activities with, identified 409 beneficiaries with youth, Orphans and Vulnerable Children (OVC) and women groups in the Lunya and Kiwonnongo surrounding villages.

#### 2.1.1.2 Analysis of the cause of problem:

The problem of illiteracy and poverty in Kiboga is increasing on daily basis, however much the government of Uganda introduced free Universal primary education some parents see it as of no realistic value. Therefore, children have been denied their right of attaining proper education. With 7 years of attending regular educations system, children are still unable to read and write English well, which is the official language of the republic of Uganda. Kiwonnongo Foundation Inc (KIFI) came up with the initiative of supporting the local children by providing a high standard, excellent and well managed education system for all, both male and female. St. Jerome Emilian Academy was then established to cater for nursery and primary level education. This comprises of excellent and standardized education system, access to meals at school, uniform, scholastic materials and accommodation for boarding section for the long distance commuters and all the above are provided to all the beneficiaries ranging from no income to average income family settings. This financial non discriminatory approach fully supports the community with no excuse of not taking the children to school. Parents and all local community members have taken ownership in the system created by Kiwonnongo Foundation Inc (KIFI) that was founded and initiated at no cost for the benefit of the surrounding Community.

With constraints of lack of source of funding and poor current service delivery lead to the absence of economical and social development of this community. Therefore it is very crucial that Kiwonnongo Foundation Inc (KIFI) applies all funds to run the fore-mentioned projects.

The project aims at reaching out to all **Children, Youth and Women** in the community and 409 beneficiaries have been identified. These are:

- All children of school age, including HIV related Orphans
- Youth that have reached adolescence stage practicing risky sexual behaviors
- Lack of basic necessities of life like clean water, food, shelter, clothes, education among others
- Lack of clean and safe water at school and community of Lunya
- Lack of proper dining facility for school children especially those at St Jerome Emilian Academy
- Children out of school that are living with HIV or orphaned and have no one to care for them
- Youth and Women living with HIV or affected by HIV and those who are the pillars of target community
