Our No Objection certificate(NOC) application to Bihar **Education department** is still pending. We had done the suggested workaround in Aug'18 to circumvent the rule of furnishing the copy of advertisement we published in Feb'14, but still it is stuck!! We are trying to reason it out with top bureaucrats, and hope that it will be resolved by Jan'19

We missed the deadline of getting CBSE affiliation for our first batch. We have worked out with other affiliated school to take our class 8th students, and are in process of finalising our arrangement with parents.

For class 7th and other students, we are trying to raise INR 60 Lakhs funding for completing part of infrastructure by Mar'19 and applying for affiliation.



We raised some more funds for science laboratory, but still short of target by significant amount. We need to urgently restart the construction for remaining portion of laboratory and furnishing in Jan'19. We plan to reach out to our supporters to fund the remaining amount to help us complete the science lab in next 3 months.





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## Stellar performance in Round 1 of SOF Science Olympiad

8 of our students get top 25 ranks in Bihar zone, 1 student in class 6 tops zone and got 10th national rank

SOF National Science Olympiad was held in end of Nov and results got declared recently. The students of class 6 and class 7 had a superb result. 7 of class 6 students got medals of distinction(given to students getting top 25 rank in zone) and 1 student of class 7 got medal of distinction. 1 class 6 student topped Bihar zone and got 10th rank nationally by scoring 55 out of 60 marks.
