To help facilitate the rebuild of infrastructure, specifically sanitation and education facilities, in areas heavily affected by the 2015 earthquake.

our hours north of Kathmandu is the village of Sarsyu, with a population of just over 2,000 residents. All 70 homes in Sarsyu were destroyed by the 2015 earthquake. The primary school of 700 students was heavily damaged and is now unsafe to use. Students are currently attending class in a temporary structure, cramming 75-80 students per classroom. As a result of overcrowded classrooms, some students are forced to walk 2-3 hours a day to attend classes in neighboring villages. Elevate Nepal Inc. would like to help facilitate the rebuilding of the primary school to give future generations of Sarsyu the education they deserve.

GOALS

Estimated Project Cost: \$80k USD

Begin Construction October 2018

- Build school to earthquake standards approved by the Nepal government and the National Reconstruction Authority (NRA)
- Build primary school containing 12 fully furnished classrooms, two stories total
- Build four toilets for school containing washbasins, soap dispensers, and running water to promote good hygiene and sanitation
- Provide school with clean drinking water
- Supply school with solar electricity
- Hire local workers for construction
- Purchase 90% local material

CURRENT PROJECT



n November 2017 Elevate Nepal, Inc. provided funding and labor to aid in the construction of six homes in the village of Kholegaon. Like many villages in Nepal, the people of Kholegaon had been living in temporary structures since the 2015 earthquake unable to find the financial assistance necessary to rebuild their homes. Through local connections and the help of international volunteers, Elevate Nepal, Inc. is building houses for six families in dire need of new homes. The construction is ongoing.

ACCOMPLISHMENTS UPON COMPLETION

Estimated Completion: April 2018

- Cleared damaged homes and rubble to make land clear for new construction
- Rebuilt homes to earthquake standards approved by the Nepal government and the National Reconstruction Authority (NRA)
- Provide cooking stoves with chimneys for better smoke ventilation
- Hired local workers for construction
- · Purchased materials locally
- Provided safe, clean homes for six different families
