All our initiatives will run in partnership with the Elected Representative of Gbarma District: Hon. Joseph M. Matthews, Jr. as well as other influential community leaders.

Many excited participants (64) registered for the classes at Gbarma Central High School (GCHS) from all over the community. They each received a handout that was prepared by the local team on technology and financial education skills. Hon. Joseph Matthew (MP) donated stationeries to the centre and classes were held in the lab.

In the last few months, teaching in the government schools in Liberia were suspended in and around the capital Monrovia. GCHS like others, was on skeletal services as teachers stayed away due to the lack of payment by the government. This created a serious setback for our teachers in implementing their duties. Once schools are back to normal, we intend to add Tuesday to the current teaching days (Thursday & Friday) to enable us catch up and achieve the goals and objectives in a timely manner.

Additionally, the pilot incubator programme for unemployed youth that want to start businesses was postponed due to a lack of finances by our hosts in Monrovia.
