The Good News

Over the last few months, we've been in discussion with our partners in Liberia about what support is needed and how we can work together to resume delivering it. Reported cases of COVID-19 remain low in Liberia, with schools and shops open but with social distancing measures in place. We are hopeful that with this and the UK government's announcement concerning vaccinations and restriction reductions, that we will be able to travel to Liberia as early as May. Although we are monitoring the situation with regards to the recent reports of Ebola in the country.

Together with one of our partners in Brewerville, we have identified the need for two incubator programmes:

- 1) for existing business owners to guide them on sustainable and ethical practices to keep their businesses open and help them thrive
- 2) for aspiring entrepreneurs to give them the tools they need to innovate and successfully

Initial enquiries estimate between 30 and 50 people would like to participate in these programmes, with varying levels of education from little or no schooling, to degree holders.

Recent updates from the Gbarma Central High School (GCHS) indicate that the ICT club we commissioned to run in October 2019 is in need of revival. We are working hard with the school and other contacts to start the club again as we know it was so valuable and loved by the GCHS students who otherwise do not have access to any Computer education or equipment.

We are also monitoring the collaboration with Pastor Deborah who runs our Womens Business club in Brewerville for which we had 18 women join and engaging in discussions with a microfinance organisation to inject some funding to support the members.

We are very hopeful that we will be in Liberia again soon and be involved in more moments like these:
