Though they have a little fight over it but I have to be relocated back to my uncle place. It was like from the frying pan to the fire, I ended up selling in the market to keep the home running, no more schooling and now a full time mother.

Somebody at the SOS who saw me selling was concern even though has littler power to take me back to SOS introduce me to one Rev Donkor who is the Head of Glory Baptist church and school. Rev Donkor encourages me to go back to school and first enroll me in their school in Grade 10. So for me to start school my Pastor who is Pastor Jude O Ebube decided to adopt me and ask me to stay with one of our church member who is presently hosting me.

Rev. Donkor who is also the chairman for Street children empowerment Organisation for Developing countries in the Gambia introduce me to one of the volunteers whom through wish I went through counselling by their team and promises to help. It was a sign of relief and hope. I am attending the glory Baptist school and all my fees arrears with the school have been paid by the organization and am really grateful to them and Rev Donkor. I was privilege to talk on WhatsApp video call with their leader in America who cried whiles I was talking. I am happy to know people cares. Now I am preparing for the grade 12 exam which will be in June but my fear is whether the organization will help me through college as I have no hope of getting support anywhere. I commit all to God as am hopeful.

Today my daughter and I are happy because Pastor Jude my adopted father is helping me and my child and now Street Children Empowerment Organisation has also come in to help with my education. I really thank God for this as am in tears of joy. May God bless the founder of this organization, Rev Donkor, Pastor Jude and all those helping as there are many like me out there looking for hope and restoration.
