Venezuela's current crisis - ongoing since 1999 - exploded in 2014 - the result of deep seated and systemic political and economic problems. Rampant food shortages and a dysfunctional supply chain that continue to limit many families to one meal a day. Much needed, in short supply medicines, add to the nation's chronic inability to meet basic quality of life and health needs.

IN THE HEART OF IT

Hospitals

It's a state of emergency in Venezuela and SAI is there...In the middle of it all...at the heart of need...helping in hospitals, victimized by Venezuela's strained, underfunded, healthcare system. One SAI campaign is making a huge difference, eliminating malnutrition, delivering more than 700 meals weekly to a children's hospital wing in Carabobo, Venezuela.

Delivering freshly prepared food twice weekly to kids and babies in need...some fighting for their very lives. Nutrition for mothers of newborns who are now, thanks to SAI, able to adequately nurse their young. We're also bringing critical medicines free of charge and directly to doctors who are vetted; providing basics like Ibuprofen to patients...helping doctors meet medical needs, improving patient quality of life and in some cases helping save life itself. We direct-deliver food to patients, while simultaneously monitoring medicine distribution making sure it arrives where it needs to, who it needs to and when it needs to.

SAI creates a path of transparency - immensely mitigating the impact, reach and scope of systemic government corruption.

Fully supporting two orphanages with 200 meals each day plus a wide range of ongoing supplies including much needed medicines, hygienic products, clothing, shoes, even toys and educational supplies. SAI is also providing clothing, shoes, medicines and hygienics to two other orphanages, and we're committed to full support of all four by end of fiscal 2018.

SAI Goals for 2018 and Beyond

- Provide 1,000 meals a week in the State of Carabobo, Venezuela.
- Provide sustainable meals throughout Venezuela.
- Increased investment in farm and agricultural development.
- Increased orphanage sponsorships.
- Doubling meals delivered-daily to a target goal of 500 or greater.
- Assisting Venezuelans living in Colombia refugee camps.
- Creating more vital jobs to help foster economic stability for all Venezuelans.
