OVERVIEW

The Educate, Equip & Empower (EEE) project is designed to tackle poverty; retention, enrollment and completion of girl child education; enable networking and mentoring between female students and women professionals around the world and provide access to opportunities for women and girls in northern Nigeria.

UPDATES: SEPTEMBER - NOVEMBER 2018

Economic empowerment and continuous mentoring for Grace, is an Educational Subsidy Programme Beneficiary who started work with EWEI in September 2018. The project has enabled EWEI take her on as a staff member and provide an opportunity for her to work and save towards her tertiary education. We have continued to provide her with access to learning materials, capacity building and is now registered to take her qualifying exam early in 2019 for consideration for possible admission into a tertiary institution.

EWEI Online, an online learning, mentoring and horizontal exchange platform hosted on Google+ communities has held a number of online chats and features daily posts and interactions on a variety of topics. Milestones include an online chat to mark the international Day of Peace on 18 September with 70 unique interactions hosted by online mentor Hiba Antoun, Programmes Manager Development for People and Nature Association, Lebanon. Another online chat on Hard and Soft skills on 23 November with 64 unique interactions hosted by online mentor Andrea Thomas Interim Director, International Education and Programmes, Farmingdale State College, New York. EWEI Online membership has also grown to 96 members who benefit from mentoring, capacity building and networking opportunities on a 5-day-a-week basis.
