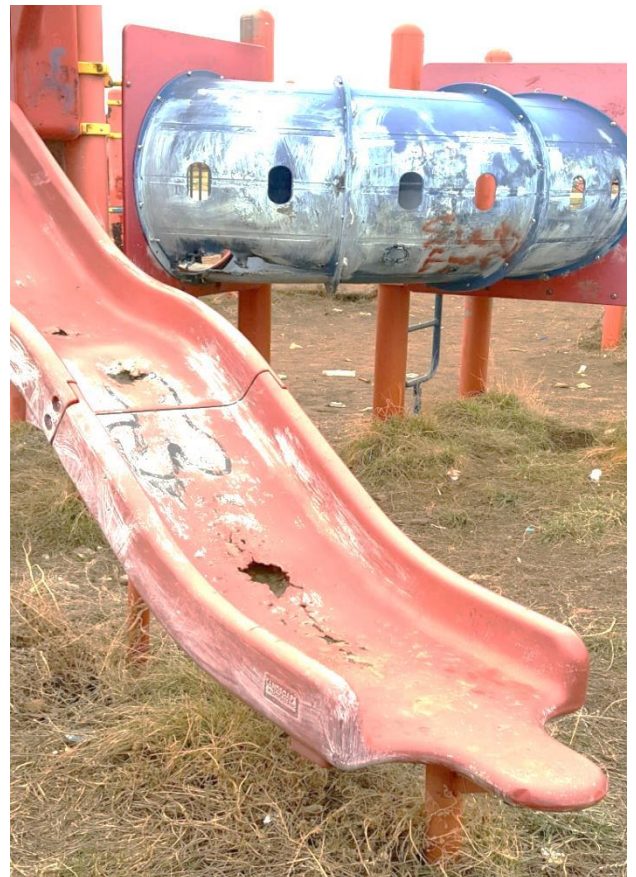
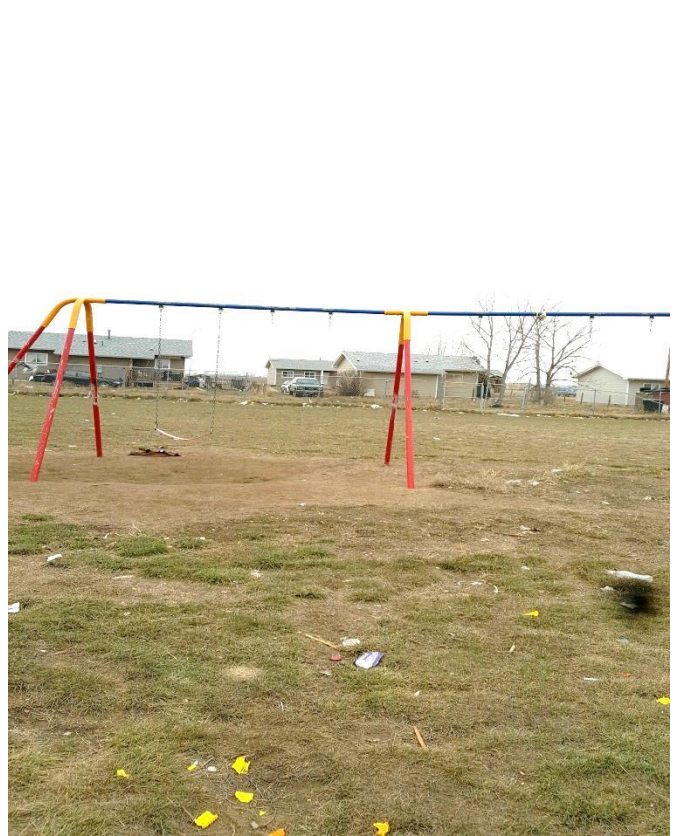

Current plans – 2018

- Currently we are in the process of dismantling the play area. Fort Peck Tribes Community Services has agreed to do the work to fulfill hours of their clients.
- Area will have to be leveled and we will solicit Fort Peck Tribes departments for assistance with gravel.

Security Plan:

Due to the amount of damage this playground has sustained, our program has talked about keeping the area secure.

- Increased security patrols on the weekends and at night by the Fort Peck Tribes Dept. of Law and Justice and concerned citizens of the surrounding area.
- Addition of signs around playgrounds, play at your own risk, area is patrolled, etc.
- Addition of utility lights.
- After completion of playground, have an “unveiling” and let residents know the costs involved with rebuilding.
- Giving incentives to FPHA residents that live near the playground to help patrol.
