On December 8, 2016, our first story hour since an election that deeply impacted marginalized communities all over the U.S., over 700 people in the Bay Area requested tickets to listen to three personal accounts on Black Lives, Immigration, and Trans Rights. This, in a space that fit 40.

In 2017, Listen for a Change:

- Featured 20 stories on 15 topics of social justice including: Islamophobia, Sexual Assault, and Refugees.
- Hosted over 1,000 attendees in 6 six different venues in San Francisco, Oakland, and New York City.
- Raised nearly \$10,000 for 17 nonprofit organizations

This is in our first year alone. The greatest thing I've learned this past year is that this space needs to exist. The potential for change is astounding.

Every story told reminds me of the thousands more left untold. Our growth will bring forth more diverse voices and reach isolated communities. It will inspire a generation of storytellers to fearlessly share their truth, and in the act, provide safe spaces of judgment-free listening for people to feel the things that matter. Not a day goes by that I'm not reminded by the power of what we do. The movement starts with you. The impact? Well, it never really ends.

Add a full-time Executive Director and a part-time Director of Development to focus on grant writing and community outreach.

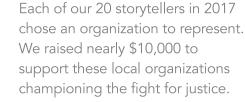
DEEPEN OUR IMPACT
