Youth With A Vision (YWAV) is a registered community based charity no. C.D. 2211. We are dedicated to defending and advocating for the rights of the disadvantaged children, so that we create for them avenues and opportunities to achieve productive and sustainable livelihoods. We run foster families, provide food, school fees and materials, healthcare, clothing, beddings, and training on leadership skills, income generating activities, vocational skills and reproductive health, for the disadvantaged children.

We organize courses on human rights and Restorative Justice to empower the community to promote the rights of the disadvantaged children. The children we work with are mainly the orphans, isolated and impoverished, and don't attend school due to lack of resources. They are often malnourished, and susceptible to diseases. There are many children who have come through YWAV and begin to change their lives. YWAV is entirely run by volunteers and supported by donations from friends.

We began working with the disadvantaged children in Uganda in 2002 in response to the HIV/AIDS orphans crisis. Since then we have been working with the most devastated children.

We are

- Providing education and supplies, food, healthcare, foster care and other essentials to the children in need, to enable them reach their potential.
- Equipping and empowering the children and youth with effective Christian leadership skills, to enable them influence positive change within their spheres of influence.
- Creating awareness of reproductive healthy and HIV/AIDS while giving support and care to the affected children, and empowering them to make informed decisions upon their health and sexual behaviour.
- Helping unemployed young people to acquire vocational skills through the Youth Centre for Skills Development
- Providing business skills and micro loans to the unemployed youth to start up their own enterprises.
- Building the capacity of the local community to support and protect the vulnerable children
- Providing life skills to the children and youth we work with
- Providing leisure time, spiritual and social events to develop the children and youth on our project.

PROJECTS

Child Sponsorship - We provide assistance of school fees and materials to the needy children to realize their educational ambitions to transform their lives.

Saturday programme - Every Saturday all children on the project come together at their centre to learn life skills and socialize.

Foster Family - We partner with the local community to provide safe homes in which we take care of the homeless and abandoned children

Feeding Programme - it is being developed to provide nutritional lunch meals to poor children who have no parents to provide them with packed lunch meals. Youth Centre for Skills Development - It is in its initial stage, meant to provide vocational skills to the jobless youth to start their own jobs. Currently we are offering computer and Art & Craft classes.

Vision Conference - we understand the pressures young people face when it comes to making crucial decisions for the future in our socially divided and troubled world. So this annual event brings together all the project children and some outsiders to socialize, make connections to discover available opportunities, share experience, knowledge, ideas and solutions to challenges they encounter, draw individual action plans for the future, encounter God and experience how to walk with Him to navigate through the challenges along their life path. It is both a life changing and trends setting conference with carefully selected speakers.

Participants are educated on various topics including health and well-being, human rights and community leadership

Global Youth Service Day - every April we mobilize young people to design and implement service and learning projects to meet the needs of their community through volunteering.

Advocacy – Because we have experienced first-hand how the ignorance on human rights results into violation and denial, which affects stability, co-existence, growth and development, we conduct regular workshops to sensitize, train and empower the local community to take up individual actions to understand, protect and promote human rights of mainly the vulnerable members of their community - orphans, widows and girl children.

Care Corner - here we aim to alleviate child poverty so we collect unwanted items and in-kind donations of clothes, shoes, food stuff, beddings, and school supplies and give them to the identified less privileged children in our community.
