

Project Report: Educate 89 Inner-City Youths and Adults

in Panamá by Academia Juntos Podemos



Overview

Juntos Podemos, is a civic social center located in the inner-city neighborhood of Curundu, in Panama, launched an initiative to educate 89 youths and adults. This program aims to provide educational opportunities and support to individuals in a community that faces significant socio-economic challenges.

Goals and Objectives

1. Increase Literacy and Education Levels: Provide foundational education to improve literacy rates among youths and adults.

2. Skill Development: Equip participants with vocational skills to enhance employability.

- 3. Community Engagement: Foster a sense of community and support through educational programs.
- 4. Personal Development: Promote personal growth and self-esteem among participants.

Implementation Strategy

1. Assessment Phase: Identify the educational needs and current skill levels of the 89 participants through initial assessments.

4. Monitoring and Evaluation: Establish a system to track the progress of participants and the effectiveness of the program.

Activities and Milestones

- 1. Recruitment and Enrollment:
- Recruited 89 participants from Curundú.
- Conducted orientation sessions to introduce the program.
- 2. Educational Sessions:
 - Organized daily classes focusing on basic literacy, numeracy, and vocational skills.
- Included life skills workshops covering topics such as financial literacy, health, and hygiene.
- 3. Community Involvement:
- Held monthly community meetings to engage families and gather feedback.
- Organized events to showcase the achievements of participants.
- 4. Progress Assessments:
 - Conducted mid-term evaluations to measure progress.
 - Provided additional support to participants who required it.

Outcomes and Impact

- 1. Literacy Improvement:
- Increased literacy levels among participants by an average of 30%.
- 50 participants successfully completed basic literacy and numeracy courses.
- 2. Vocational Skills:
 - 39 participants acquired vocational skills in areas such as carpentry, sewing, and computer literacy.
 - Several participants secured employment or started small businesses.
