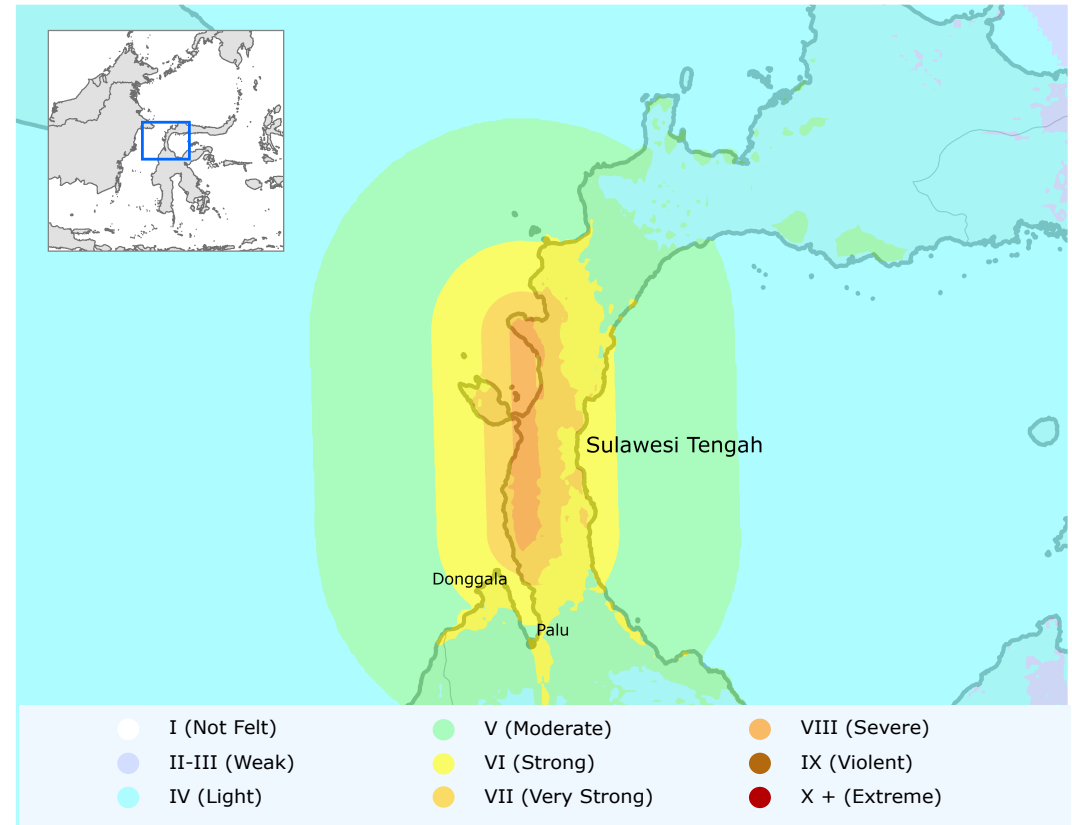

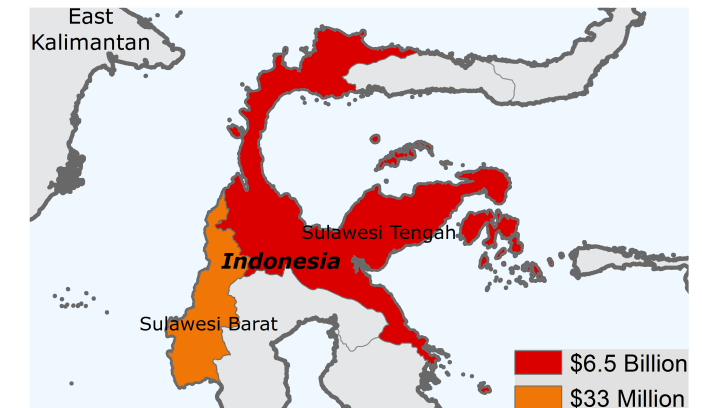
Exposed Population
