RE: Hurricane Michael

OCT 11th, 2018 - Charlotte, NC – The Veterans Rescue and Response Team, has lessened its relief efforts of Hurricane Florence to focus on the newer area of distress after the more recent hurricane, Hurricane Michael.

We have activated ourselves as a mobile response team to assist in the evacuation, rapid response and debris efforts alongside willing and needing counties in the wake of Hurricane Michael. The usage of our military veteran crew, totaling 4, will be instrumental in helping with rescue efforts will be made to provide first aid and first aid response due to the high call volume that surrounding counties EMS, police and dispatch will receive: thus helping them by being the eyes to assess and let them know the true level of their needs, as they will be stretched thin.

Though the overall activation of our crew is volunteer, it comes with costs and we normally assume those costs of our own free will and are not contractual with FEMA or other such government entities.
