Spreading Menstrual Education



Project Update Report

July - September 2022

Project Pavitra is a collaborative initiative with IAHV's sister organisation, the Art of Living to empower women through menstrual education. Since the launch in March 2018, our trainers have delivered complimentary workshops on menstrual health and hygiene to over 1,22,300+ adolescent girls. 5,829+ females have been trained to become menstrual health and hygiene champions in 24 states of India, 11 countries in Africa, Bhutan, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Cambodia, and Hong Kong.

Pavitra Trainers have conducted a series of menstrual awareness workshops in Butwal, Nepal from June - August with more than 350 participants



In the month of July, our Pavitra volunteers in Bhilai, Chhattisgarh, conducted workshops for Government girls middle and higher secondary school students of Vaishali Nagar with more than 641 participants



Pavitra volunteer Priya Lalwani and her team in Ratlam, Madhya Pradesh, conducted workshops in Saint Paul Convent School and Saint Peters Senior secondary school, Jaora with over 520 participants



Faridabad District Administration and IAHV Project Pavitra team executed a partnership project to spread menstrual hygiene education amongst adolescent girls in Government schools of Faridabad district. So far we have reached over 2000 girls
