STEM Advantage "levels the playing field" by empowering talented students, who are mostly **low-income**, **first-generation** college students, attending California State University, the *largest and most ethnically diverse 4-year public university system in the nation*, with access to networks, employment and economic mobility that students attending a private university receive, including:

- Paid internships to help students gain real-world experience
- 1-to-1 mentors to provide a role model, support, guidance and coaching
- Scholarships to attend classes full-time and graduate with less student debt
- Professional development and career panels to prepare for their job search
- Community, including a sense of belonging, support, motivation, and opportunities to build their network

Our new **Freshmen STEM Career Pathways program** engages first year college students, especially women, Black and Latinx students, provides exposure to STEM career opportunities, and drives persistence in a STEM major.
