Emergency Care**

Providing immediate, safe and temporary care within a comforting family for children in crisis. EC is a maximum 90-day stay with specially trained families kept on retainer around Phnom Penh.




**Kinship Care  
Long Term Care Within the

Empowering biological parents and/or extended family to provide long-term care for a vulnerable related child. If a child can safely stay in their own family, that's the best result we can hope for.



**Outreach  
Partnering to Provide Care**

Providing training and capacity building, organisational coaching and resourcing to staff in orphanages who want to begin returning children to their families and helping them be cared for at home.



**OSCaR  
Case Management System**

Developing a web-based system that provides quick and accurate information gathering in a central hub. Child development and outcomes can be easily and reliably monitored, making both social work practice and data-collection simpler and more reliable.



**Foster Care  
Long Term Care**

Empowering Cambodian families to provide short and long-term care in their local communities for one or two non-related children who have been abandoned, orphaned, trafficked, abused, or institutionalized.

Supporting families to provide for the optimal health and well-being of children with disabilities, maximizing each child's potential, and promoting inclusion and participation within the community.



**Church Partnership  
Encouraging Engagement**

Encouraging local Khmer churches to engage with their communities and play a role in caring for the vulnerable among them. Equipping the people with greater knowledge and awareness of the issues their neighbors face, and leading them to grow in love and compassion.
