

SUMMARY

Odessa Development Fund (ODF) is a public organization that creates and determines interesting projects for the further implementation of them. ODF is a non-profit, non-governmental and nonpartisan organization. The projects are implemented by own and attracted resources.

The main mission of Odessa Development Fund is improving the welfare and living standards of the population of the Odessa. Achievement main mission is ensured raise next objectives: the sustained socio-economic growth of the city and citizens, high-quality rates of economic growth of the city, strengthening the competitive position of Odessa in Ukraine and in the world. These objectives provide via various indicators, including improving health, access to the educational and cultural processes, to reliable pieces of information, to free-barrier and friendly infrastructure, etc.

The projects are implemented within the framework of the principles of freedom of choice - democratic norms, gender equality; environmental protection - animal and plant worlds; the participation of all members of society - residents, business, and municipal bodies.

Odessa Development Fund, in its activity, cooperates with the Odessa City Council, the various donors, and other non-governmental organizations, directly with the citizens of Odessa to achieve the desired mission.

Odessa Development Fund actively started, after reorganization in Dec 2015, its activity in Feb 2016.

BRIEF REPORT

The forum Odessa 5T (1st July 2016) – attended by over 300 participants from 10 countries, including World Bank, EBRD, EIB, NEFCO, as well as partners from China, South Korea and the United States. According to the results of the Forum was signed 8 Memorandums on intentions to invest in the city's economy and further development of transport infrastructure, tourism and waste recycling industries, and given shocks for a number of investment intentions and negotiations.

«Odessa 5T» became a new Investment Brand of the City, which combine FIVE key areas: Transport, Technology, Tourism, Trade and Trust.

The presented strategy continues to be implemented by the authorized departments and municipal enterprises of the Odessa City Council to this day. President of ODF is a member of the Investment Council under the Odessa City Council.

In July 2016 project is implemented by the Odessa School of Energy Agency (OSEA), created on the basis of enterprise «Agency of Odessa Development Program» in cooperation with the NGO «Odessa Development Fund».

On the occasion of project implementation representatives of the three schools in Odessa (№1, №43 and №100) have successfully participated in the training in Lviv 22-24 February 2016. As a result of the training representatives of the project in Odessa prepared energy audits, was developed a model implementation of the program and certain ways of its realization.

At present, in the aforementioned schools study and provide the necessary information to the Odessa coordinator of the Project.

This project will be implemented during February-October 2016.

Replacing the lighting system in the school gym

The Pilot Project on the replace of the lighting system on the energy-efficient lighting in the school gym of the secondary school №1 has been successfully implemented!

31st March 2016, in a secondary school №1, located in Odessa on the Mikhailovskaya Square, was ceremonial opening a renewed school gym with complete replacement of old lighting systems on modern light-emitting-diode (LED) lamps.

The Pilot Project has been carried out with the support of the Odessa Municipal Energy Agency (OMEA) and the Odessa Development Fund. Financing of the purchase of lamps has implemented the Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) GmbH on behalf of the German Government. Active assistance to the implementation of the project has provided the deputy of the Odessa City Council, the chairman of the Permanent Commission on Housing and Public Utilities, Ecology and Emergency Situations of the Odessa City Council - Mr. Alexander Ivanitsky.

The old lighting system, which was installed in the gym, has been completely both morally and physically worn out: mercury lamps are quite unsafe for usage in schools, especially in the gym, as they can be easily damaged by ball; mercury lamps do not provide adequate level and

The old lighting system, which was installed in the gym, has been completely both morally and physically worn out: mercury lamps are quite unsafe for usage in schools, especially in the gym, as they can be easily damaged by ball; mercury lamps do not provide adequate level and quality of illumination, that have negative influence on sight of learners. Besides, considerable part of the lamps has not worked, because they are located at a height of 6.4 meters, which hampers their timely replacement.

Increased levels of energy efficiency for internal illumination systems and energy saving are very important point in modern positions, considering that educational facilities are financed from the municipal budget. The updated illumination system has allowed to lower number of mercury lamps (40 units) up to 20 LED lamps, that makes it much easier their servicing (due an elongate lifetime of LED lamps). At the same time, energy consumption has been reduced by 1500 watt-hour, and illumination intensity has grown by more than three times - from 80 lux to 250 lux.

In front of beginning work, calculation and visualization were performed by using specialized software DIALux 4.12. This has allowed to outline the technical requirements and location of lamps for achieving better ergonomic and economic parameters.

27th April 2016, supported by the Odessa City Council and the Odessa Development Fund 1000 lux held a seminar for Housing Cooperatives (“condominiums” in European meaning) and Building Cooperatives on theme “Apartment House: Basics of Energy Efficiency”. Seminar was conducted in the framework of Project of IFC International Financial Corporation - “Energy efficiency in the Residential Sector of Ukraine”.

The event was attended by about 90 representatives of Condominiums and Building Cooperatives of the City of Odessa.

Opening of the seminar was followed by introductory speech the Deputy Mayor of Odessa Pavel Vagelstein. He has noted the importance and relevance of the energy efficiency in our city and emphasized that the Odessa City Council considers necessary the implementation of such measures and programs and provides comprehensive support with their side.

Director of Odessa City Council Department of Economic Development Mr. Grigory Fedusko has stressed Program of the Odessa City Council for support of energy saving measures. Seminar participants were informed about the procedure of consideration for the part of loans from the state and city budgets. The chairman of the Condominiums and Building cooperatives, who have already participated in this program, have shared their experience. For today, already three Condominiums and Building cooperatives have taken the opportunity to obtain such cooperation.

During the seminar, an expert on the modernization of housing systems Mr. Andrey Dybanin and project expert of IFC Mr. Vadim Shalashov have described the engineering basis of the internal modernization, ways of setting of funds and basic systems of energy efficiency measures in the Apartment House. Also, project expert of IFC Mr. Nikolay Shum has substantiated to the seminar participants a financial feasibility for measures on the internal modernization of houses. The issues of loans and aspects of energy efficiency measures were given the most attention. IFC project experts have noted that they would provide free consultation for all existing or prospective of the Condominiums and Building cooperatives, who will take decisions to implement of the energy efficiency measures at its housing cooperatives.

The seminar closed with series of questionnaires and individual consultations of experts for all working as participants of seminar.

Odessa Street Art Festival 2016

30th July 2016, within the framework of Odessa Street Art Festival were held master classes in street art, pottery, sculpting, painting and drawing.

However, special attention was given to street art contest as an one of the walls of park of the Heroes Defense of Odessa. So, one of the walls (300 meters in length and more than 2 meters in height) of park of the Heroes Defense of Odessa (6th station of Velykyya Formany) has become a like huge coloring book. Each interested participant was able to make his mark in the creation of street art object, alone or with the support of painters. For this purpose has been prepared 400 liters of paint of 46 colors, and the wall has been divided into special sectors in different shapes and sizes. Children with enthusiasm have helped parents to decorate the building blocks of wall in the framework of the concept for the preparation of a common canvas and leave colorful imprints of their hands at the allocated sectors of white colors. It is worth noting that the paint was on a water basis and meet to the necessary requirements that do not have any negative impact and easily washed off by water from hands.

And now the views of Odessa, as well as pictures-gifts from guests, may delight of residents and guests of our city. Work on the decoration of the wall continue by painters of Studio Reach.

MoreInfo, Odessa – Monument de Ribas

Was installed a free zone with tourist navigation at the monument one of the founders of Odessa city - Monument de Ribas.

Touristic project MoreInfo with the support of the NGO "Odessa Development Fund" was installed the first a navigation of the project MoreInfo in Odessa.

Project MoreInfo represents a placement of navigation with QR codes near the monuments, historical objects of the architecture, socially significant objects. when scanning by mobile phone will appear access to the article about these object, allowing to read information about the object without waiting away from him and in the absence of tour guide, and on the 7 languages (Ukrainian, English, Russian, German, French, Turkish and Chinese). It also provides monitoring the number of tourists who visited object located close to place. Increase of quantity of tourists for next season, decrease amount of tourists, making the amount of time spent near the monuments and the frequency of visits.

As the first point of interest of Odessa, near which was installed zone with a navigation, selected a monument one of the founders of Odessa – Monument de Ribas.

In Odessa, plan to install more 10 points with the QR-code at most significant landmarks of Odessa. Keep for Updates.
