PROGRAMS

To fulfill our mission, we implement social investment programs that could be defined as strategies that we plan, seek and execute to promote fundamental and lasting changes on some social problems, linked to the strengthening processes of the Foundation. Likewise, through our programs we generate local and regional development, promoting relevant initiatives, respectful of the environment and the cultural diversity existing in Oaxaca.

• COMMUNITY SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Our objective with this program is to contribute to community strengthening through the support of students of Oaxacan communities, of scarce resources and academic excellence, with the granting of an economic stimulus that encourages each student in their school achievement, educational permanence and culmination of their studies.

After the earthquakes of September 2017, the community of Asunción Ixtaltepec suffered severe damage, not only to their homes and community buildings, but also to the local economy with destruction or damage to their livelihoods. With the impact on their income, families begin to dispense with the resources allocated to other areas, one of which is the



education of their children. Many of the young people of the Oaxacan communities can not study due to the lack of economic resources, which is why we present this proposal and thus offer them an opportunity to continue their high school studies.

Challenge

Currently in Mexico The dropout rate ranges between 13.3 and 15.5%. , particularly in the state of Oaxaca, represents 14.2%. Although in recent years it has been declining, according to official figures between 600 and 700 thousand young people a year leave the EMS. According to the INEE "in the framework of compulsory education, upper secondary education reflects an important bottleneck" (INEE, 2017).

At this moment we have 58 young people from Asunción Ixtaltepec, Oaxaca, who could access a scholarship that allows them to continue for one more year with their baccalaureate studies.

Solution

A scholarship will allow these young people of Ixtaltepec to continue with their baccalaureate studies, which opens a window of opportunity for them to acquire more knowledge, involvement with the community and, in the future, wider possibilities to study a university career that will facilitate them. access to work life.

It is important to point out that as scholars of Fundación Comunitaria Oaxaca, young people have to develop a community Project.

Long term

The educational process that young people live in the upper secondary level is of great relevance for community life. Therefore, influencing their educational process by providing the opportunity to maintain and conclude, will have an impact, in the long term, in their own community.
