


# Indigenous women united for reconstruction

## THE AYUUK REGION

It is located north of the State of Oaxaca. The basins of the Papaloapam, Coatzacoalcos and Tehuantepec Rivers are born in its mountains.










Ayuuk peoples maintain a high sense of identity and cultural cohesion.





In Ayuuk municipalities and communities, important traditions are preserved for the fulfillment of services or community positions that are carried out free of charge.





The relationship with nature and collaborative work are the basis of community life.



► The community, the houses and the plot are spaces of family coexistence and reproduction of the culture, where all the members participate actively.





The affectations suffered by the earthquake of September 2017 represent great challenges and showed the vulnerability of the communities.







The heavy rains caused the lack of communication, lack of food supply and greater losses due to the floods, which made the situation even more difficult.



The CODICE team promotes collaboration to strengthen community capacities, emphasizing the support and recognition of indigenous women.







# The team carries out tours through the communities to register the precarious state of the kitchens, walls and roofs.







Meetings are organized with local authorities, affected people, mainly women. In order to guide and accompany the reconstruction and management of supports.







Liaison actions are carried out for municipal and community authorities to access food and other support from collection centers set up by the State Government and sister organizations, even from other states.







Direct support is channeled to strengthen ties of solidarity between women from different regions.







# Actions to rebuild family and community life.

Training, advice and accompaniment is provided to the Authorities and women's groups to advance in the reconstruction of family and community life with a sustainable and integral approach.







Support has been provided for the roofing of kitchens in affected indigenous communities.







Meetings and workshops are held, both for the definition and organization of the work.

It is about maintaining a collective, inclusive and transparent process.





With the support of the Semillas fund, training is provided for the preparation of firewood stoves type "LOLA" that corresponds to an adequate design for these communities, consumes less firewood and eliminates smoke in the kitchen.

Wastewater treatment system at family and community level.






Training and advice for the management of solid waste (garbage) is provided since with the help, a large quantity of packaging and disposables arrived.











Work continues on the reconstruction plan, seeking to restore the social fabric and community life, taking measures to reduce vulnerability.



#### **WORK PROPOSAL 2019**

For this year we seek to replicate the experience in another community of the municipality of Asunción Cacalotepec Mixes, benefiting 50 families.

For this we are presenting a proposal to Gloval Giving "Indigenous woman united for reconstruction" for 20 thousand dollars.

The objective: Create capacities to reduce vulnerability and create greater resilience in families affected by the 2017 earthquakes in the mountain region of the Isthmus of Oaxaca Mexico.
