Program Details:

- Program offerings range from 8-30 weeks long, once a week after school. Each program is led by a local high school or college age volunteer and staffed with additional youth volunteers.
- Many of our students have decided to pursue careers in the marine industry and developed a strong affinity towards marine conservation and science.
- By the end of our program sessions, students leave with a much better understanding of local marine ecosystems.
- Our students become volunteers themselves and some have even served as Directors for programs that they once were in.
- Hundreds of youth volunteers serve as positive role models in their communities while promoting environmental stewardship.
