Creative, playful, energy...

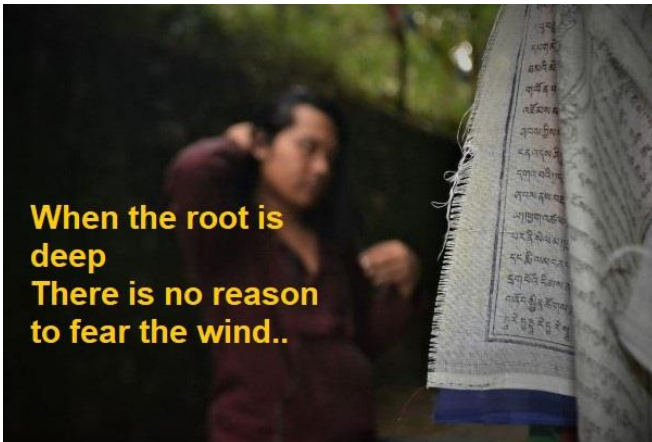
Covid-19 is not a restriction, nor the end of normality, it is for many a real hardship, and for some it is a challenge to be encountered

A reminder that **YOU** are very much part of the IGWR family. Nurturing and giving life to those who need your support, your kids!



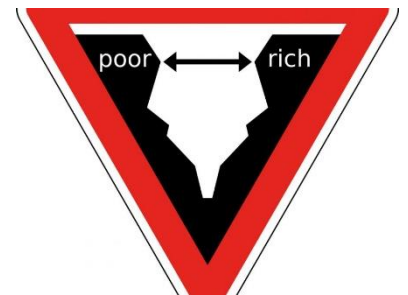
Educating children provides the capacity to grow; and to realise a future beyond mere survival.
