Some of our graduates are now working in hospitals, banks, hospitality and small local businesses, some are following their passion for in the world of art and music.



Our 'family of families' approach often finds our students in late-night conversations, discussing their plans and their goals. We are inspired by their different visions and equally inspired by the generosity of all who make this possible.

That's why we support over 40 students across 10 schools and universities, and also over 45 students in remote Nepal through our education programs – ensuring access to quality education and safe learning environments.

She is looking to establish the program with a number of rural schools, as this will leverage our mission to improve the opportunities for educating children in Nepal.

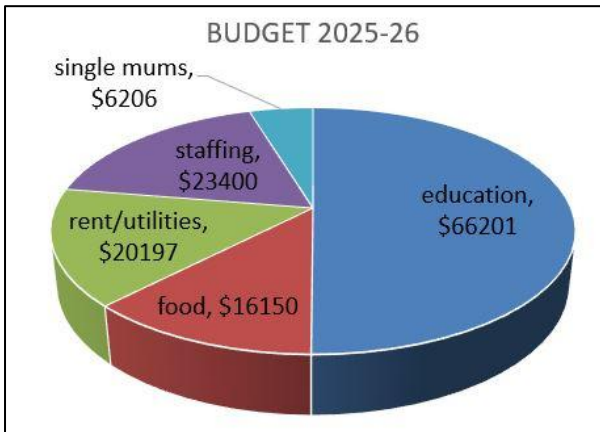


Visits that help and inspire.

Financial update...



Our Budget for 2025-26 is \$132,154 for our primary areas of operation supporting 40 students, running our two hostels for some of the students and giving monthly essential support to a number of single mothers.

With two education specialists on the committee, we are also looking at programs to support Rural Schools and to provide teacher training, and these activities will run as distinct projects with their own budget and sources of funding.

And a great way to introduce your friends to the work of IGWR-Nepal that you support.

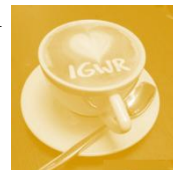
