We have delighted in taking individual 'kids' through their kindy to university years, staying with them like caring parents, giving them an opportunity to grow into their true potential.

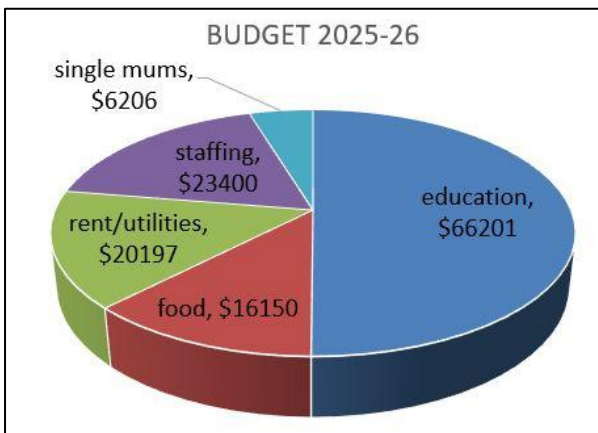
We also work with rural schools and rural schoolteachers, for we also know that the schools also need help and encouragement to be able to better deliver their services to whole school communities.

Financial summary...

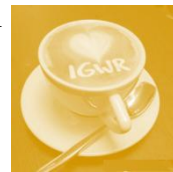


Our Budget for 2025-26 is \$132,154 for our primary areas of operation supporting 40 students, running our two hostels for some of the students and giving monthly essential support to a number of single mothers.

With two education specialists on the committee, we are also looking at programs to support Rural Schools and to provide teacher training, and these activities will run as distinct projects with their own budget and sources of funding.
