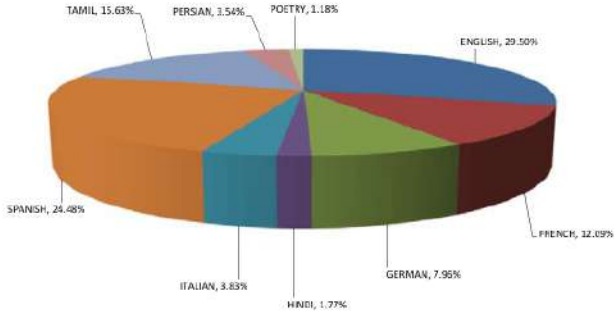

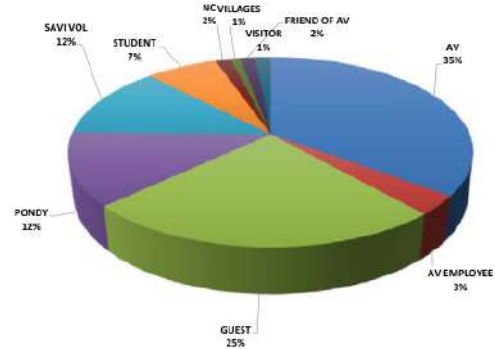
**% OF STUDENTS BY LANGUAGE 2024 - 2025**
