1. We have expanded to 50 monitoring sites!

The number of monitoring sites was only 27 in 2018 and now it has developed to 50. And we are planning to hold around 300 times of monitoring in this year.

2. Offline training held in Shenzhen last December went successfully!

Before the monitoring officially starts, our monitoring partners across the country gathered in Shenzhen and participated in training for three days. On 7th Dec, partners participated in Zero Waste Conference held by China Zero Waste Alliance. On 8th Dec, our staff summarized the project achievement in the last year, gave the technique guide and organized field practice of monitoring and cleanup. On 9th Dec, we held the project implementation training and invited partners of old monitoring sites to share their experience.
