• Groundbreaking of the Science Lab

Last spring, Hekima Place asked for support to fund a very important project. We know that if we all want to be part of the solution to break cyclical poverty for the girls and women in Kenya, it's critical that we remove barriers and provide them with educational opportunities that will allow them to advance. Because it's increasingly difficult for women to break into the science fields, we're working to be part of a solution by building a science lab on the Hekima Hills campus to provide educational pathways for girls into science-related careers.

Our new science lab will provide resources, including books, technology, and teachers, for the girls at Hekima Hills Learning Centre. We're happy to share that throughout 2022 crews in Kenya have been hard at work and the science lab is now ready for the new semester.

This lab would not be possible without you, thank you so much for continuing to invest in the lives of the children at Hekima Place.
