### our Projects

#### YOUNG ADVOCATES FOR SOCIAL

**HARMONY (YASH)** is a group of young advocates from vulnerable communities who are trained in child rights and in the art of advocacy. These young citizens are provided with supplementary education, health checkups, daily nutrition and numerous co-curricular opportunities.

**HAQ KI SHOR** networks and sensitizes the schools and NGOs in child rights. Students are provided with varied platforms for skill development as advocates for the UN Global Goals. They come together and hold sessions regularly in various centres across the country. More than 40 NGOs and 55 schools in Delhi are part of this network.

House Of Kidizens facilitates a nation-wide network of Children's Parliaments (CP) in collaboration with other child rights organizations and schools. The elected representatives of these CPs from various states meet regularly to discuss the issues and concerns of children, and to design child centric policy asks that they seek from various levels of duty bearers. In pursuit of this, child ministers are capacitated through workshops and training sessions. The campaign has 5000+ child advocates in 23 states and union territories.



#### NINEISMINE

PRATYeK convenes the national level participatory advocacy initiative of, for and by children called **NINE**IS**MINE**. The campaign seeks 6% for Education and 3% for Health (now 5%)

of the GDP public spending as promised by the Indian Government in 2004 and hence gets the name "9 is mine". The campaign currently works towards meeting the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).
