OUR ACHIEVEMENTS

- Establishment of a Nursery and primary school for the vulnerable children in Kakiri town
- More than 52 needy children are given free education with scholastic materials.
- Vocational studies including; computer skills, football, music, devotion, dance and cookery are taught to children
- A home recording studio to boost the music talent was set up.
- Parents are given counseling sessions to overcome their domestic challenges

CHALLENGES

- Increasing number of vulnerable children due to domestic violence, early pregnancies, HIV/AIDS and polygamous families, create more demand for our services amidst limited resources.
- Lack of enough space for educational activities, boarding facilities for vulnerable children and space for the community sensitization.
- Lack of enough instructional materials for formal and vocational educational activities.
- Limited support from the foundation directors and the well wishers to deliver quality services.

FUTURE PLANS

- Establish a full Boarding primary and secondary school for the vulnerable children
- Set up a vocational training wing for the vulnerable, single mothers and un privileged children in the community
- Establish an Audio Visual studio to embellish the music talent for self sustainability.
- Set up a music school wing that will help to pass on skills on instrument playing, compositions etc.
- Strengthen the issue of ICT skills to compete with the growing technology
- Acquire land for agriculture to reduce on high costs of food and set up also agricultural projects for foundation sustainability .
- Mobilize funds through talent shows, sports runs, foundation dinners and project proposals.

CLIENTS ATTENDED TO:

- 52 Children have acquired free education
- 86 children have acquired half bursaries (paying a small part of the tuition)
- 20 single mothers have acquired counseling services, assistance in domestic challenges and part time employment at the foundation
- 11 cases of domestic violence have been referred to higher authorities for further management.
- 4 physical and mental cases been linked to care to medical service providers

AREA OF COVERAGE

- Currently the foundation focuses her activities in Wakiso District as one of the most affected and most populated district in Uganda found in the central part of the country, though a few clients out side this district have been attended to.

- IT knowledge to both young and adult
