COMPLETE SCHOOL TRANSFORMATION

The programme endeavours to bring the learning levels and infrastructure of Government schools 'at par' with other schools by providing Remedial Education to students, strengthening teaching capacity and enhancing engagements with parents and communities.

Remedial Education & Counselling



Augment learning competency; enhance parental engagement; provide psychosocial support

Capacity Enhancement



Training of teachers, Head Masters and School Management Committee; linkages with government department

WASH Facilities (Water Sanitation and Hygiene) in School



Functional toilets; hand washing platforms; drinking water facilities; focused workshops on hygiene practices (menstrual hygiene)

Health and Sanitation



Improve health outcomes by strengthening health care delivery services; organising health camps

Increase awareness and facilities for achieving desired sanitation levels

School Infrastructure



Whitewashing; furniture; beautification; classroom painting, RO plants, solar grids

Learning Tools



Digital lab; computer lab; STEM lab (*Science Technology Engineering and Maths*); subject labs, libraries

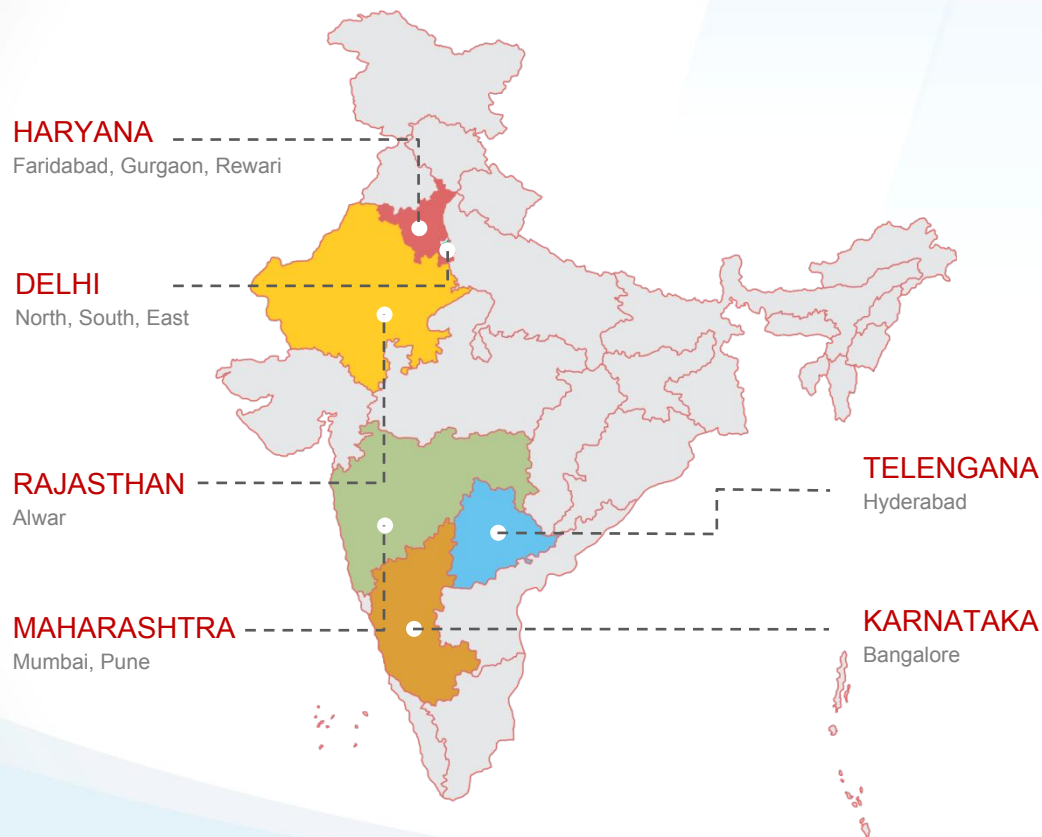
