The importance of vision in elderly people

In old age, vision is no longer just a sense: it becomes an essential tool for maintaining independence, security and a link to the world around you. Seeing clearly means being able to read a doctor's prescription, distinguish steps when walking, identify loved ones, or simply enjoy the colours of the sunrise from the window at home.

For older people, regaining or retaining their sight means improving their quality of life and restoring their dignity and autonomy. It allows them to continue to make decisions about their care, to participate actively in family and community life, and to reduce the risks of falls, accidents in the home, social isolation and cognitive decline.

At ACREC, we witness how cataract surgery or a timely consultation can transform an older person's life: no longer relying on others to dress or walk, cooking, reading, embroidering or going to the shop unaccompanied. It is a profound transformation that goes beyond the physical. It is giving back light, hope and a sense of belonging.

Therefore, maintaining a commitment to the visual health of older people is not only a medical action: it is an act of social justice and humanity.



Thanks to your generous support, during the months of May and June we were able to perform 44 ophthalmological surgeries that have transformed the lives of elderly people in vulnerable situations. Each intervention restored light, autonomy and hope to those who can now enjoy meaningful activities such as reading, walking safely or simply looking at their loved ones.

Each surgery represents much more than a medical procedure: it is a new opportunity for someone to achieve their personal goals, regain their independence and reconnect with life from a new perspective. 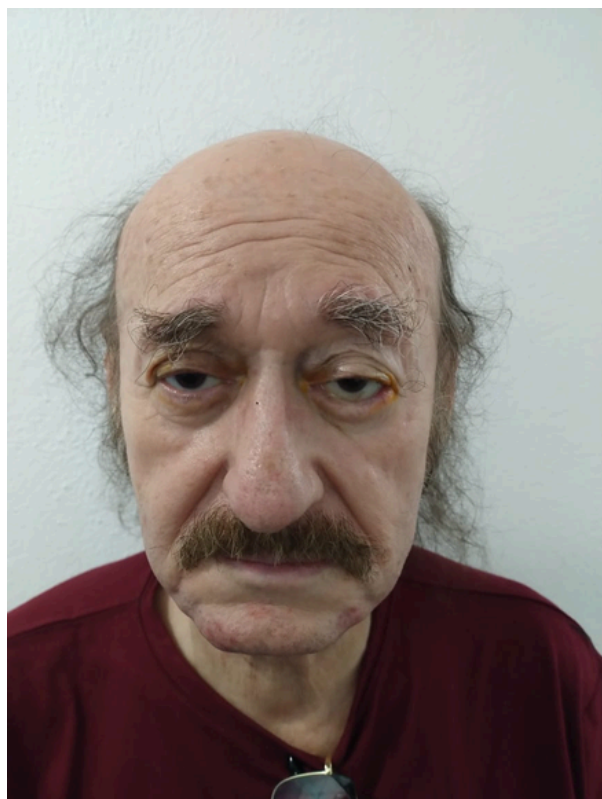

I am Lilia, 74 years old, with cataracts in both eyes. This letter is to thank you from the bottom of my heart for your support.

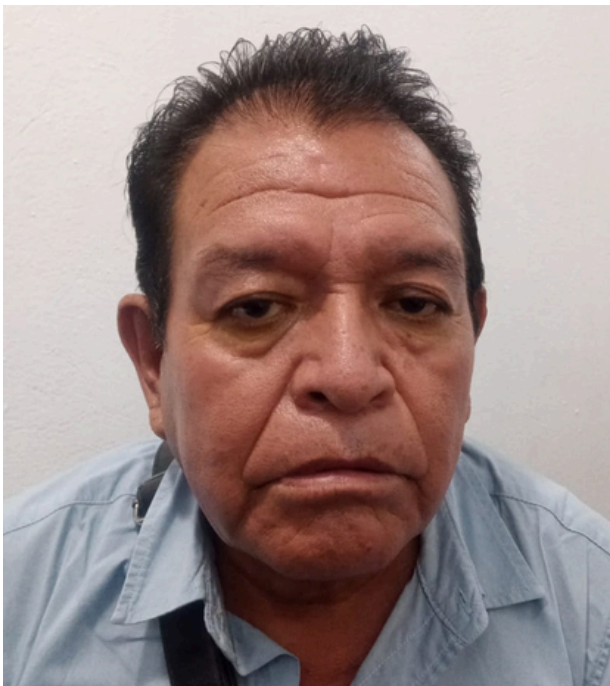
As a senior citizen, unemployed and with other comorbidities, I have no other income.

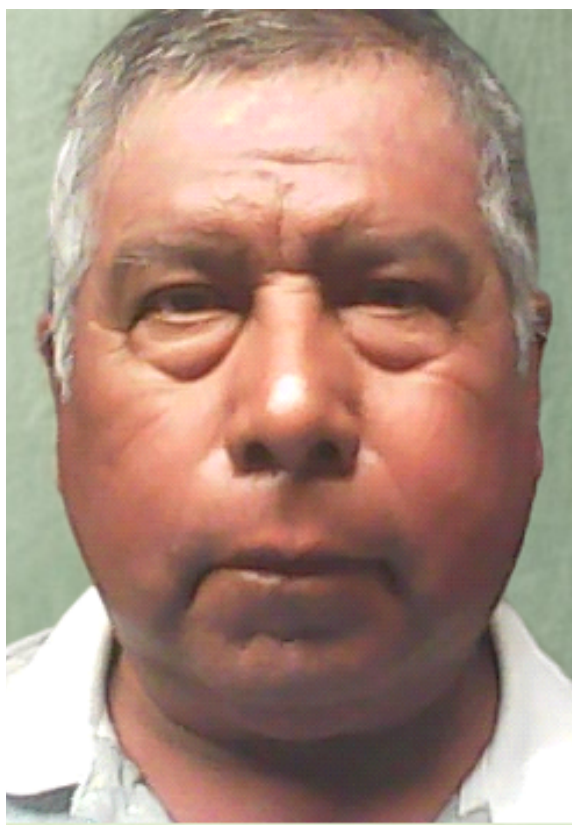

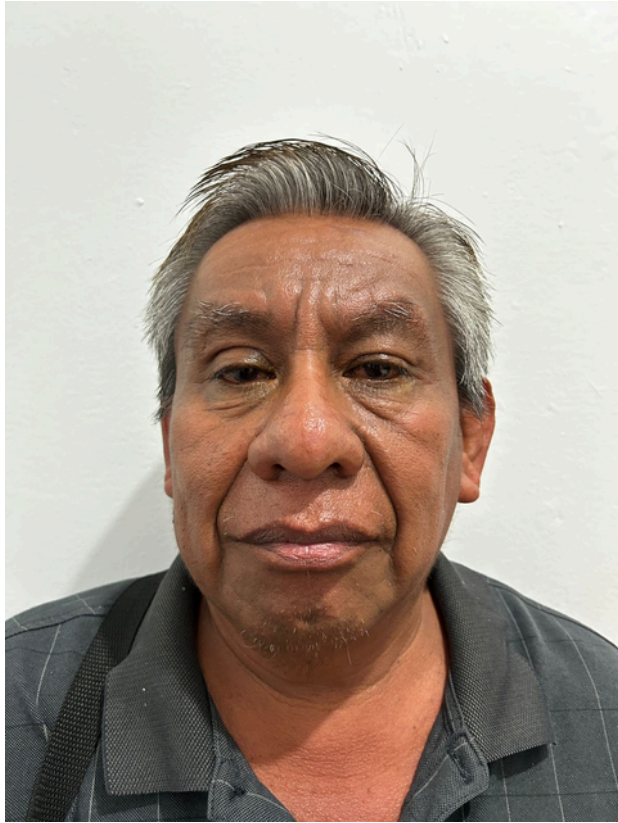

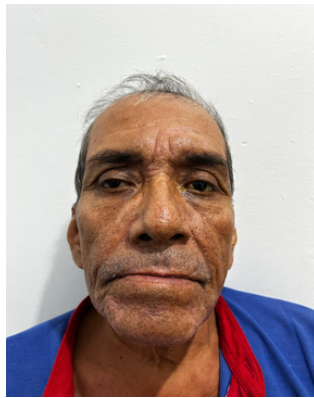
I, Abel, find it difficult to work because I can't see well out of my eyes, I see very blurry, and that's why I can't work, because it's very difficult for me.

I ask God's blessings for the GlobalGiving donors. Thank you, thank you very much. God bless you.



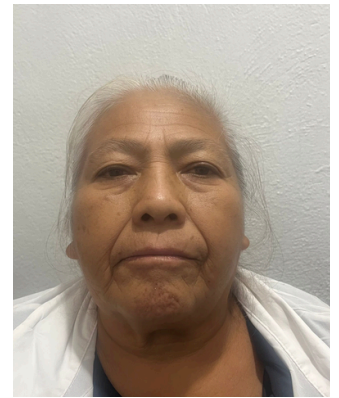

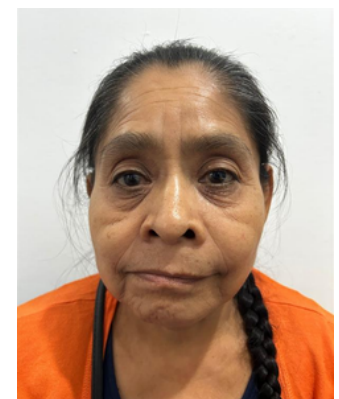
