Introduction

In old age, sight ceases to be merely a sense and becomes a fundamental tool that guarantees independence, safety and contact with the environment. Being able to see clearly means understanding a prescription, recognising steps when walking, identifying loved ones or simply enjoying the view from the window of one's home.

For older people, preserving or restoring their vision means significantly improving their quality of life and restoring their autonomy and dignity. It allows them to make decisions about their own care, participate actively in family and community life, and reduce the risk of falls, accidents in the home, social isolation and cognitive decline.

At ACREC, we witness how cataract surgery or a timely consultation can transform the life of an older adult: walking again without depending on others, preparing their own meals, reading, embroidering or going to the shop on their own. It is a profound transformation that goes beyond the physical: it is about restoring light, hope and the possibility of feeling like an active part of society.

Therefore, maintaining our commitment to the visual health of older people is our duty and, at the same time, an act of love, social justice and humanity towards those who have given us so much.

Thanks to your valuable support, **during July and August we provided care to 43 people in vulnerable situations**, restoring light and hope through ophthalmic surgical procedures.

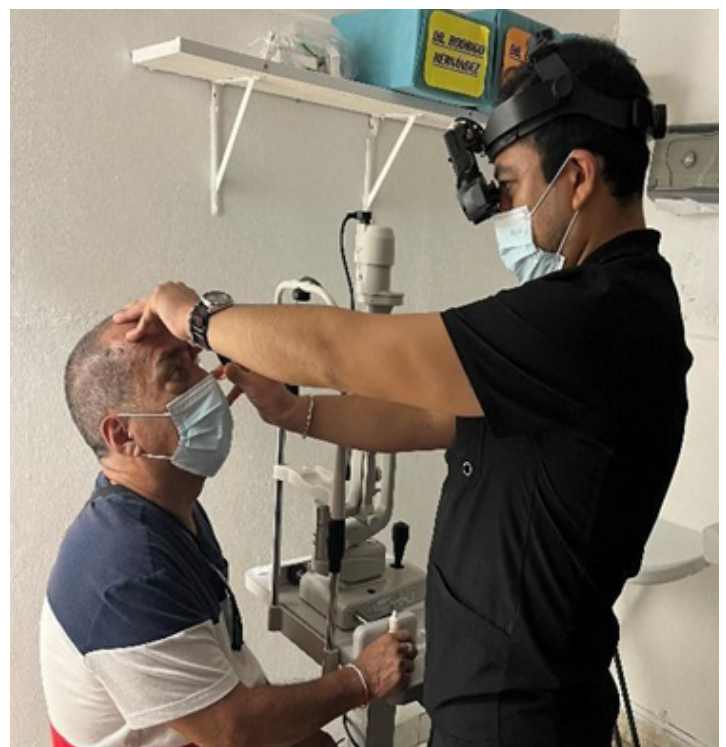
