ORGANIZATIONAL PROFILE

Introduction:

BUDO is Somalia based humanitarian and development organization working in Somalia on humanitarian, relief, recovery, development and emergency response through national and international partnership. The organization was founded by a group of Somali professional both men and women from all over Somalia and the Diaspora communities. Foundation came after the key founders carried out assessment on the grounds situation of the ill-hearted Somali communities affected by both man-made and natural disasters in rural and urban areas.

Bulay Development Organization (BUDO) was founded on the 25th October 2006 in Bulaburte of Hiran Region. The organization is registered by the Ministry of Interior of the Somali Federal Government (SFG), the regional and district administration of SC regions, Somali NGOs consortium, Hiran Regional Education Committee (HREC), elders and recognized in Kenya by the Somalia Embassy in Nairobi.

The organization is headquartered in Mogadishu, the capital city of Somalia with operational office that undertakes all management and administrative issues of the organizational programs. BUDO has board of directors consisting of three (3) members. The BOD meets twice in a month.

BUDO as a development agency is involved in emergency humanitarian response to the Somali in transition. The organization also works in collaboration with the international agencies, the Diaspora and local communities aiming at far reaching integral development for a better Somalia and society.

Vision:

- To be an excellent organization in philanthropic participatory approaches to lifting the dehumanizing conditions of communities, social and economic sustainable alternative, dedicated to strengthening and building the capacities of partnering communities in central Somalia and beyond.

Mission:

- Commitment to realizing communities whose various category members are free from dehumanizing conditions with the reduced impact of poverty, diseases, illiteracy and discrimination, children.

Core values:

- Respect for fundamental human dignity and respect for universal human law
- Peaceful coexistence
- Gender sensitive,
- Social accountability and transparency
- Democracy, justice and good governance
- Social and economic equity

Objectives

- Carry out livelihood activities and capacity needs of the community members especially the children, orphans, youth, women, widows/widowers and the aged members of the communities.
- Facilitate the community members on perceptions and attitudes change, communication and interpersonal relationships for improved living at personal and community levels, gender equity, human rights and good governance.
- Rehabilitate, re-integrate and provide support to the affected categories of the community members.
- Provide essential career advice, vocational education and skills for alternative enterprise to women and youths.
- Collaborate and network with other developmental organizations locally and internationally for the development of the partner communities.
- Mobilize, raise, and disburse funds and other resources for the promotion and achievement of the objectives of the organization.
- Get into an agreement with the government or authority to obtain any rights, privileges and concessions which the organization deems fitting to obtain.
- Appeal to the government, authority, public bodies, private sector or any institution proper to the objectives of the organization for and to receive resources, grants or finances or any other kind of assistance for promoting the objectives of the organization.
- Accumulate, lend, advance or give credit or loan to the instituted community groups upon such security as may be deemed proper by the organization.
- Take such steps by personal or written appeals, public meetings / gatherings or otherwise as may be deemed fitting by the organization for the purpose of receiving resources or funds in form of donations, subscriptions or otherwise for the promotion of the objectives of the organization.
- Take any appropriate measures, steps and activities as may be incidental to or conducive for the promotion of the objectives of the organization.

BUDO and its Activities

The principal goal of BUDO's programs is to alleviate poverty by building the capacity of the communities to meet their livelihood needs through:-

- Intensive agriculture along annual streams and canals in Central Somalia
- Environmental conservations and fighting against climate change through tree planting
- Fighting against diseases, including HIV/AIDS epidemic where only 600 persons are receiving HIV care and over 300 are on ARV therapy as of statistics of Concept Note for Round 8 GFATM HIV/AIDS Proposal.
- Carrying out participatory action related to the development and livelihood needs of children, the youth, women, aged and marginalized communities.
- Rehabilitating and advocating for employment by providing essential education, vocational, technical training and career advice to youths especially school drop outs, street girls/boys, child soldiers and freelance militias.
- Providing technical advice, entrepreneurship training in ethical and clean business practices, to youths (female and male) and small scale traders (men and women).
- Building community consciousness and awareness in peaceful co-existence, good governance, gender empowerment and equity, environmental development and protection.
