3.1 Activities conducted by the Medical Mobile Unit for the period of January 2022:

- Hemoglobin follow-up: The iron folic acid, vitamin C tablets were provided in follow up to anemic women detected in screening camp conducted. Total 15 adolescent girls & 06 women were given the medicine.
- 2) Activities conducted at Livelihood Training centre: General Health Camps for Tailoring, Beautician & Computer departments were conducted at livelihood training center, Dhasai. The awareness sessions on Hand Wash Activity were conducted at Livelihood Training centre, Dhasai for beneficiaries of tailoring, beautician computer & staff members. The data of attendees needed to be filled in the app.
- 3) Data Input: The app needs to be updated as it's in the development stage. There are certain technical issues which would be resolved & the app will be up to the mark soon. So, the up-to-date, data input of patients & beneficiaries, is hampered to an extent as it is expected to happen during any new initiative.
