Natural disasters are particularly hard on low-income families. In response to the destruction caused by Hurricane Florence, WARM is focused on a long-term rebuilding process.



Respond

- Contact all 174 homeowners on pre-storm waiting list
- Identify urgent/critical damage
- Community engagement to collect new applicants
- Send out "Tarp Teams" - prevent further damage



Repair

- Address immediate needs like lack of running water
- Begin working on hurricane related damages
- Ensure homes are healthy & habitable



Rebuild

- Make homes stronger than they were before the storm
- Prepare homes for long-term safety & resilience
- Strengthen home for future natural disasters
