The mission of the We Are Together Africa Campaign is to provide disadvantaged youth in South Africa with good quality education to try and end the cycle of poverty in their lives.

We Are Together Education Programme

HOW IT WORKS:

The RISE Foundation has been operating the We Are Together Education Programme supporting 48 children for two years. We have been paying the school fees of all the children of school-age at the Agape orphanage. Through education, our programme provides these children with the opportunity of a sustainable future, empowering them to help themselves and lead independent lives. Our education programme pays for the children to attend excellent schools that have been hand picked for each child. We also hire a tutor to come for two hours every day after school to help the children with their homework. The tutor not only provides the children with academic support but also some of the encouragement and support

that they would have normally received from their parents. This holistic approach is proving very and the successful children's grades have improved significantly. One of our aims is to raise enough funds to enable us to hire more tutors so that the children can have more individualized and specialist support.

EDUCATION SYSTEM:

The education system in South Africa makes it very hard for disadvantaged children to afford to attend good quality schools. We have managed to secure places for some primary and secondary children at the best schools in the area – what are known as 'Ex-Model C schools' The remaining children, who are not yet ready academically for Ex-

Model C schools, will attend middle tier schools while also being supported by our tutor, until they are academically ready and would benefit from an Ex Model C environment. Both types of school pride themselves on outstanding academic results - the difference being in the school fees and the facilities available. However, our longterm plan is to raise sufficient funds in 2009 to enable more children to attend the Ex Model C schools next year.

This year, while ensuring that all the children can attend significantly better schools, we have also managed to reduce the annual running cost of our education programme to £15,000



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REDUCED COSTS & FURTHER EDUCATION:

This year, while ensuring that all the children can attend significantly better schools, we have also managed to reduce the running cost of our education programme. We have negotiated a charitable rate with the schools as well as with the stationery and uniform suppliers. Our annual running costs now account to £15,000 (all of this is spent on the ground in South Africa). With this sum, we are financing the education of 48 children and 3 further education students; this includes school fees as well as the necessary stationery and school uniform and tutor.

Our further education students are three young adults who have recently graduated with their high school diplomas as a result of our education programme. Each of these learners are following their own individualized learning path and we are supporting their further studies, which include a university course in Music, a game reserve guide training course and a Pre and Post HIV Test Counseling course.

PARTNERS:

We work closely with the Kwazulu-Natal Department of Education to ensure that our children receive the best education available to them. We also work in partnership with managers at Agape Child Care Centre, principals at each of the schools and tutors who help with their homework to ensure that we can support the children in the best possible way.

Situational Overview

According to the *UN Convention on the Rights of a Child* all children and young people have a comprehensive set of rights. It is our collective responsibility to ensure that these rights are implemented around the world. Within these stated articles is the right for all children to reach the highest level of education that they are capable of and the right to an education that will develop their personalities, abilities and talents to the fullest potential.

The goal of the We Are Together Campaign is to ensure that the children of Agape and other disadvantaged children get access to the same high level of education available to children from more privileged backgrounds. We believe that a good quality education has the power to challenge the cycle of poverty and disease that is particularly devastating in countries such as South Africa. In the province of Kwazulu Natal, where the Agape children live, 1 in 3 adults are HIV positive.



Thus, in order for these children to have a chance in life and to develop the potential that we see so clearly in them, they desperately need access to good quality education.

Programme Objectives

Sustainability

Alongside raising funds for the annual running costs of the our Education Programme, we have also been fundraising for an Education Trust Fund that will enable us to run the programme for many years into the future. This will not only provide the children with a stable education but means we won't desert them if the programme were to ever raise insufficient funds. Once our target base of £300,000 has been reached, the Trust Fund is designed to sustain itself so that the base investment is never spent and in doing so will ensure the annual education costs of approx. 50 children are always covered. We have made significant progress towards our target with £100,000 already in the trust fund.

Objectives

- To raise £15,000 annually over a period of three years to cover the ground costs of our We Are Together Education Programme for the next three years, 2009-2011
- To raise an additional £200,000 for our Education Trust Fund which will ensure the education of 50 children after 2011 and forever in perpetuity.
- To ensure that the children of Agape orphanage and others like them receive the education and support that they need to become self sustaining and confident adults
- To tailor each child's education to suit their abilities and needs in order to support them better.

BUDGET

Within our budget, the difference Management/Fundraising in school fees among the schools is clear to see. The better facilitated have Ex-Model schools C significantly higher fees. To deal with this we have negotiated discounted rates with the schools and we also seek out individual sponsors to support the costs of children attending these schools. These sponsors have lowered the annual costs of our programme to £15K and thus make it possible for us to send some of the children to these Ex-Model C schools without significantly increasing the costs of our Education Programme. To run the Education Programme and build up the Education Trust Fund we rely on the generosity and support of individuals and foundations such as yours.

costs:

Our office is run by one part consultant and governed by a board of trustees. We work with the support of volunteers in both the UK and South Africa who help us to carry out our work. All school fees and related education costs are paid directly to schools and suppliers to ensure efficiency and accountability. A large percentage of our fundraising and administration costs are covered in kind by RISE Films. Our policy is to keep our fundraising costs limited to a maximum of 15% of overall funds raised.
