Blind Faith's Services:

- <u>Advocate:</u> speak to elected officials about the importance of maintaining valuable funding in budget line items.
- <u>Direct Support</u>: Sit with families and/or consumers as they begin the mental health journey (hospitalizations or doctor's visits).
- <u>Educate:</u> Workshops on different topics throughout the year to help educate the general public, families and consumers.
- <u>Inspire</u>: Provide hope and inspiration to families through individual conversation, family meetings and public speaking.
- <u>Outreach:</u> Assist churches in setting up their mental health ministries and programs.
- <u>Additional Services:</u> Individualized services provided, as needed. Contact *Blind Faith* to discuss.
