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BACKGROUND

Nigeria, the largest country in Africa has a population of over 200 million as of today. Most of the people in Nigeria are living below the poverty line and are facing many problems such as, lack of health care, unemployment and education and thus so many live-in Poverty. Poverty has always been the major cause of no formal education. This in turn has contributed to the decadence of the value system as children are now used by terrorist in carrying out attacks as well as sex/ labor slaves.

The poverty situation in Nigeria context, reflects in the Federal Capital Territory Abuja. The families in slums and rural areas are usually large and often face the problems of survival which is usually targeted at the earning member of the family who are unable to cope. This leads to the prioritization of needs in line with the family earning power. Subsequently, so many children have had to wonder the streets playing or begging while their mates are in schools. That is the reason so many children are not in school.

THE NEED

Education has been identified as the driving force for national development. However, in recent times, the growing number of out of school children in Nigeria has drawn concerns from both the local and international community. Nigeria is ranked as having the highest number of out school children in the world (site source). In October 2018, the Universal Basic Education Commission (UBEC) had stated that the number of out of school children in the country had increased to about 13.2 million.

Consequent to this threatening concern is the need for an immediate intentional effort to address the problem. The 2019 Edu 1K project is aimed at enrolling and sustaining 1000 out of school children through their basic education cycle. In addition, the project seeks to embark on a community enlightenment and children mentoring program to change the narratives.

TARGET GROUP

Indigent children between 5 – 15 years age who are not currently enrolled in a school are the primary focus of the 2019 Edu1K project. The foundation focuses on disadvantaged children emphasizing children abandoned by one or both parents, children from poor families, internally displaced children and children who belong to poor socio-economic conditions.

PROPOSED PROJECT AREA

Abuja is the capital of Nigeria and a beautiful city to behold, but in all its magnificence, there are many rural communities suffering neglect with many living much below the poverty level. It's really difficult for parents to send their wards to school with such conditions. Over 40,000 children are out of school in the region and hoping to attend school someday. From our visits to several communities, the predominant gender out of school is the female child and it's well known that this neglect shouldn't be given to the female child; at least not at this level of civilization. The region has public primary schools in almost all its local communities that offer "free education". This is actually not free because they'll still have to pay for PTA fees, uniforms, school books, registration fees, school bags, writing materials and they need continuous check and monitoring.

THE 2019 EDU1K PROJECT

The **Edu 1K project** is aimed at supporting at least 1000 indigent children across the FCT and Nassarawa State gain access to free and quality education, in line with the vision 2030 Sustainable Development Goals outlined by the United Nation.

This project will primarily support the enrolment and training of needy children of primary level to acquire formal education and entrepreneurial skills. It intends to provide opportunities for student experimentation which involves parents, teachers and mentor participation and utilize the partnerships with the community in trying to champion development initiatives.

This is not a one-off kind of sponsorship; it will involve continuous monitoring, performance evaluation and the supply of the basic needs of these kids throughout their primary school period. It's a realizable project and we believe that effectively fulfilling this project will lead to a bigger and better future for thousands that will be affected.

PROJECT GOALS AND OBJECTIVES:

The goal of the 2019 Edu1k project is for indigent and underprivileged children to have access lifelong quality education and skills necessary to negotiate key life decisions. Specifically, the project seeks to achieve the following outcomes:

- * Reduce the number of out of school children
- Increase the child-friendliness of school environment
- Increase the community awareness on the need for quality education
- Increase collaboration with other organizations to support policies and programs that promote quality education
- Promote the entrepreneurship education in young stars
- Provide and promote an early friendly mentorship for disadvantaged children

 Carryout a need analysis to determine socio-economic disadvantaged families that can't afford basic education for their kids in identified communities

Enrolment

• Take the kids to the schools in their various communities for psychological and class determination tests. Kids that are qualified to start will be enrolled

Measurement and Evaluation

 Enrolled kids will be saved in the management system setup solely for the purpose of feeding and tracking the progress of the kids. Setup up a volunteer-pupil mentorship system that will ensure that the kids get additional learning and training outside the normal learning period to get them up to speed with learning. Visitations and educational events will be planned and executed for the kids to further improve/enhance their confidence and exposure.
