In February 2010, Colombian soldier Corporal Pérez stepped on a landmine in the state of Norte de Santander. Corporal Pérez was seriously wounded from the explosion and suffered the loss of both legs and several fingers on his left hand.

With the support from UFC and its American **Solidarity program**, Corporal Pérez started his medical care in July 2011 at the Mayo Clinic in Rochester, MN. Corporal Pérez is thrilled to be the Guest of Honor at the conference. Soon to be walking on two new legs, Pérez will celebrate his remarkable medical recovery with hundreds of conference participants and UFC supporters.







United for Colombia and Rotary International celebrate a very successful partnership to help 26 children

On Friday, March 16, 2012 **UFC** and **Rotary International** celebrated the successful five-year disbursement of a **\$140,000** grant to fund orthopedic rehabilitation for **26** child landmine victims. Seventeen members from Rotary International – representing cities and countries from around the world – visited UFC's operations in Colombia. Rotarians were able to visit with UFC's youth beneficiaries at Otto Bock, a world-renowned prosthesis manufacturer and treatment center in Bogotá. The Rotarians had a unique opportunity to hear the children's amazing medical recoveries and their triumphant stories of survival during their visit, such as Carlos Jhordan and Lina Angulo.

UFC is working on strengthening its vital partnership with Rotary International to continue support of its **A Step to Hope** program in Colombia. Through the program, severely wounded, maimed and disabled children receive annual orthopedic care and rehabilitation, including technologically-advanced prosthetic devices every year. This miracle gives children their youth back, opening new doors of hope for a better and happier future.
