

OUR PROGRAMMES

Olive Green Outreach Foundation runs the following programs:

1. TREE PLANTING PROGRAM

The tree planting program started in December 2015 and targeted areas that have been affected by deforestation and also agricultural land reclaimed after loosing its fertility. This is broken down into the following activities: (1) **IDENTIFICATION** of areas of operation (2) **SEEDLING:** Preparation & management (3) PLANTING is done on daily basis and continuously.

2. ORGANIC FARMING PROGRAM

The organic farming program has ensured that households have adequate food to feed families and ensure that children do not go to school hungry. The program encourages women to use the available resources to setup back radigardens.

3. SCHOOL SPONSORSHIP PROGRAM

The school sponsorship program aims at putting into school every school going child into school. The program puts into school with boys and girls and has put education first for all children. The program also discourages all forms of child labour that denies children the opportunity for a decent education.

4. COMMUNITY SPORTS PROGRAM

The Community Sports Program was set up in January 2016 to curb the problem of lack of recreational activities in various villages that were experiencing problems of children being involved in drugs, hunting (poaching), illegal fishing e.t.c. These are activities that children engage instead of being in school. They have been counter productive to

children's school progression and undermined central governments efforts to provide education to children in rural or far places.

The recreation activities we design and implement include: (1) Football (2) Netball (3) Volley Ball (4) Athletics (5) Chess e.t.c.

The Sports activities have bee an integral part of the overall effort to ensure children and members of the community are healthy and kept away from vices during holidays and school breaks.

We work with the Ministry of General Education, Ministry of Youth Sport and Child Development. We also work with various stakeholders which include faith and non faith based organisations.

5. WOMEN EMPOWERMENT PROGRAM

Women Empowerment Program identifies women strengths and empowering them with training and skills to be more productive for their homes and communities in order to thrive through being productive from using their talents.

The activities include: (1) Training in tailoring (2) Crafts making (3) Backyard gardening (4) Traditional dancing & signing

TAILORING: We provide training of women in toiling ti learn how to make African clothes for the African and global markets.

CRAFTS: Women involved in producing items for sale need market where to sell items they produce. Normally markets are not in communities they live in. Olive Green Outreach Foundations assists women in finding markets where to sell the products they produce.

BACKYARD GARDENING: This has helped to reduce hunger in house holds by ensuring that families have adequate food to eat.

TRADITIONAL DANCING & SINGING: Keeps the community traditions and culture intact and talented women are called upon from time to time during ceremonies to show case their skills. It is a source of a livelihood for some and is encouraged as a profession.
