To participate in these meetings, teams from the Municipal Education Departments were organized in different ways, respecting the idiosyncrasies of each region. We can identify some strategies used:

- Individual participation in the educator's preferred spaces
- Organization of collective spaces by SMEs for the collective participation of teachers from the Municipal Education Network
- Meeting of some educators to participate in small groups
- Among other formats, which brought benefits for reflection on the themes presented and pedagogical practices carried out.

Below are some records of the collective space organized by the Municipal Secretariat of João Pessoa, on June 7, 2024, bringing together the 3 groups of educators in the municipality.



• Participation in Congresses, seminars and conversation circles

From June 12th to 14th, 2024, Ika Fleury, Maria Regina and Maria Cristina participated in the V International Congress of Inclusive Education and V Chilean Brazilian Journey of Inclusive Education in Campina Grande/PB, with the presentation of the LEGO® Braille Bricks Program at the activities in oral





communication, in addition to being present as listeners in the numerous lectures and activities organized.



FDNC representatives visited the Campina Grande Institute for the Blind, where they had the opportunity to learn about the services developed by this Institution.





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• LEGO[®] Braille Bricks workshop with employees from the FDNC

The objective of the workshop was to create educational activities with LEGO[®] Braille Bricks and other playful elements. The participants (16) developed the themes of the activities using the National Common Curricular Base – BNCC (early childhood education and first years of primary education) as a guide for their work.

The workshop was held on June 20, 2024.





• Monitoring and evaluation visit to the Braille Bricks Program

ka Fleury, representative of the Lego[®] Braille Bricks Program by the Dorina Nowill Foundation for the Blind, carried out a monitoring visit to the Professor Ezequiel Ramos Municipal School, in São José do Rio Preto, watching the pedagogical activities carried out with the 2nd year elementary school class







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• II LEGO Braille Bricks Award

The LEGO[®] Braille Bricks Award is in its 2nd edition and consists of a competition aimed at educators who are certified in the Educator Training Course to use the LEGO[®] Braille Bricks Resource and who promote inclusive education in their classrooms.

The selected works must meet 3 (three) main requirements:

- Be innovative
- Have practical application
- Promote the improvement of the literacy process for blind and visually impaired students in inclusive learning environments.

In order to guarantee technical rigor, the event must follow a schedule that covers from the date of submission of works by teachers to the award ceremony, in an in-person event in São Paulo/SP
