• Receipt of kits at the Municipal Departments of Education

On August 23 and 28, the LEGO Braille Bricks kits were delivered, respectively, to the Municipal Departments of Education of Cachoeira do Sul/RS and Sumaré/SP. In both municipalities, those responsible for Inclusive Education of the Municipal Departments of Education held a reception ceremony.

In addition, we traveled 32,559.2 kilometers to reach 23 municipalities in the National Territory so that 3,052 LEGO Braille Bricks kits can be delivered. In August, 2,895 kits were delivered and later, after the arrival of a new batch, the remaining 157 kits will be delivered. They will be used in 1,648 schools and 18 entities specialized in Visual impairment.

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• II Face-to-Face Meeting of Tutors of the LEGO Braille Bricks Program – 19/09/2024

On 09/19/2024, at the headquarters of the Dorina Nowill Foundation for the Blind, the II Face-to-Face Meeting of Tutors of the LEGO Braille Bricks Program took place. The objective of the event was to carry out an improvement training with the Program's tutors. Among the proposed activities, the tutors took a guided tour of the Dorina Foundation, developed a workshop with the National Common Curricular Base – BNCC (early childhood education and first years of elementary school) as a guide for the work. In a second moment, the tutors and coordinators of the tutors had the opportunity to hold a meeting with the pedagogical team for clarification and clarification of doubts for the next meetings and activities with the students of the 11th Edition of the Training Course. At the end of the meeting, a conversation circle was held with people with visual impairments, such as Marina Yonashiro, digital accessibility consultant, and João Maia, the first blind photographer to cover two Paralympics.

In all, 36 people participated in the event.

• Delivery of Certificates – Cotia/SP

Technicians from the Municipal Department of Education of Cotia prepared a training proposal to replicate the professionals who started working with visually impaired students this year and who did not participate in the training course in 2023. The training took place through asynchronous and synchronous





meetings, also using as a tool, the classes available on the YouTube platform, used in the LEGO Braille Bricks Program Training Course in 2023. On August 26, certificates were delivered to the students approved in this training. The event was attended by the Secretary of Education of Cotia, representatives of the Dorina Foundation and the SME of Cotia, and the graduates.
