1. Meeting at the Museum of Art of Rio – Rio de Janeiro/RJ

Partnerships with municipalities and specialized institutions will be established through a Cooperation Agreement, signed by their respective legal representatives. And after all parties sign the partnership terms, the enrolled educators will start the training course in March 2025, and LEGO Braille Bricks kits® will also be donated to the Municipal Departments of Education and Specialized Institutions.

- **VII Municipal Congress of Education of São Paulo**

Aiming to explore the dialogue between different areas of knowledge and the pedagogical practices carried out in schools, promoting a more effective education for students' learning, the VII Municipal Congress of Education, had as its theme "Connecting Knowledge for Practice". The main objective of the event is to promote qualified reflection around guiding concepts of the City Curriculum: equity, inclusive and integral education, being a broad formative action for educators of the Municipal Education Network of São Paulo. The 2024 edition of the event took place on November 27, 28 and 29.

On November 28, Bianca Chaló, pedagogue at the Dorina Nowill Foundation for the Blind, held a workshop, with the theme "Diversification of strategies for everyone's learning, with the use of LEGO® Braille Bricks, for 100 professionals from the municipal education network; and Ika Fleury, General Coordinator of the LEGO Braille Bricks Program, participated in the "Conversation Circle 4 – Network Forming Network" with the theme "Accessibility for literacy: Contextualization of practices for students with Hearing Impairment and Visual Impairment".



- **Participation in the Congress "Enchant and Empower to Resignify an Inclusive School"**

On December 5th, the three workshops registered and approved by the technical-scientific committee were held at the event "Enchanting and Empowering to Resignify an Inclusive School", of the VIII Symposium on Inclusive Education and Adaptations (SEIA), VI International Symposium on Distance Education (SIEaD) and I International Seminar of PROFEI (SIPROFEI). There were 40 participants enrolled in each workshop.
